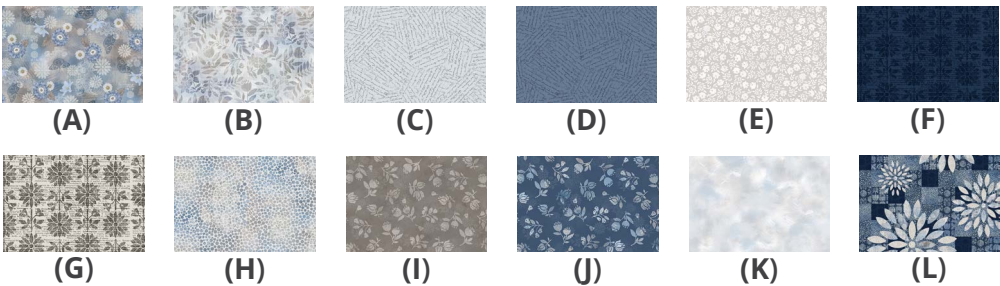

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Fabric Requirements

(D) Precious Letters	Denim	9000-17	½ yard (0.46m)
(E) Modern Calico	Light Taupe	9001-33	¾ yard (0.34m)
(F) Stem Flower	Indigo	9002-77*	1¾ yards (1.26m)
(G) Stem Flower	Medium Taupe	9002-93	¾ yard (0.34m)

Additional Materials:

- 100% Cotton Thread
- 17" x 40" piece of fusible web
- 40 wt thread for machine appliqué
- Batting: 80" x 92" (2.03m x 2.34m)

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CUTTING

Notes:

- Please make sure to check *studiofabrics.net* for pattern updates prior to starting the project.
- All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvedge to selvedge edge unless otherwise noted.
- Set aside the appliqué fabric and follow instructions for appliqué before cutting.

Fabric A, cut:

- (3) 4½" x WOF; subcut
- (24) 4½" squares
- (8) orange peels using the template on page 10

Fabrics B, E, and G, from *each* cut:

- (2) 4½" x WOF; subcut
- (16) 4½" squares

Fabric C, cut:

- (1) 10" x WOF; subcut
- (2) 10" squares
- (8) 4½" squares
- (2) 4½" x WOF; subcut
- (16) 4½" squares, total of (24)
- (3) 1½" x WOF for border 4 (top/bottom only!)

Fabric D, cut:

- (6) 2½" x WOF for border 2

Fabric F, cut:

- (2) 6½" x WOF; subcut
- (8) 6½" squares
- (9) 2½" x WOF for binding
- (6) 1½" x WOF for border 3
- (4) circles using the template

Fabric H, cut:

- (8) orange peels using the template

Fabric I, cut:

- (2) 10" x WOF; subcut
- (6) 10" squares

Fabric J, cut:

- (2) 6½" x WOF; subcut:
- (8) 6½" squares
- (6) 4½" squares
- (2) 4½" x WOF; subcut
- (12) 4½" squares, total of (18)

Fabric K, cut:

- (1) 10" x WOF; subcut
- (4) 10" squares
- (5) 1½" x WOF for border 1

Fabric L, cut:

- (1) 40½" x 50½" rectangle

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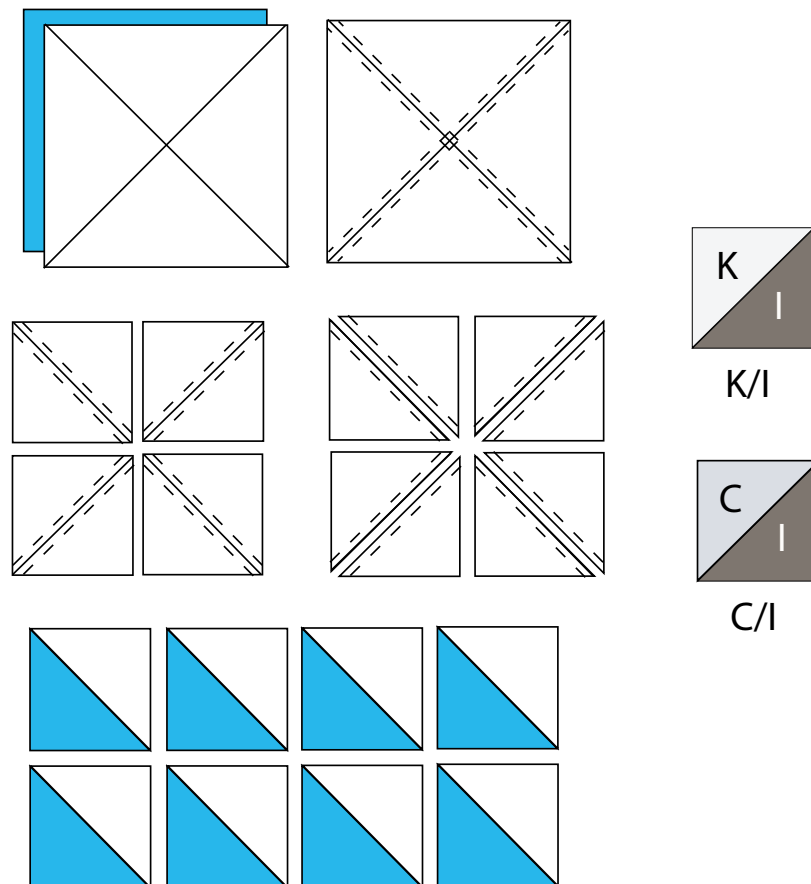
SEWING

Note: All seam allowances are $\frac{1}{4}$ " (0.64cm). Sew pieces with right sides together. Press seam allowances open unless otherwise indicated.

BLOCK A

1. Draw two diagonal lines on the wrong side of the (1) 10" **Fabric K** square. Layer a marked **Fabric K** square atop a 10" **Fabric I** square. Stitch $\frac{1}{4}$ " from each side of the diagonal lines, cut vertically and horizontally to make four equal squares, then cut each square on the drawn lines to make eight half-square triangles. Flip open, press, and trim dog ears. Repeat with (3) 10" squares each of **Fabrics K** and **I** to make (32) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " **K/I** half-square triangles (HST) (**Fig. 1**).
2. Repeat step 1 with (2) 10" squares each of **Fabrics C** and **I** to make (16) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " **C/I** HST (**Fig. 1**).

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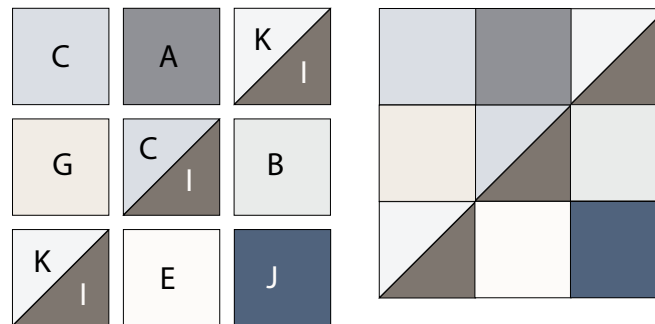
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3. Gather (1) 4½" square each of **Fabrics A, B, C, E, G, and J**, (2) **K/I** HST, and (1) **C/I** HST. Arrange the squares and HST in 3 rows of 3 as shown, noting the placement and orientation of the HST. Sew the units in rows, press the seams in opposite directions, then sew the rows together. Press the seams in one direction. Repeat to make (16) 12½" blocks A (**Fig. 2**).

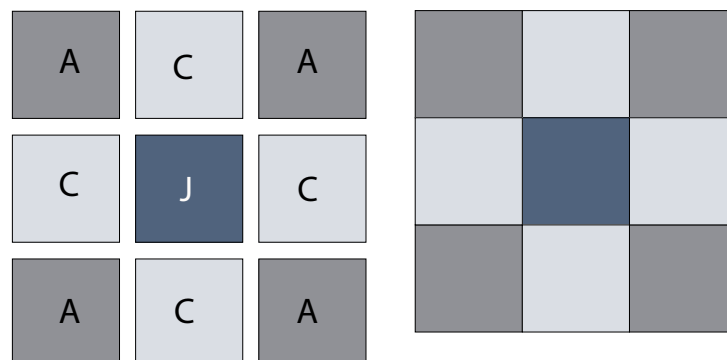

BLOCK B

4. Arrange (4) 4½" squares each of **Fabrics A and C**, and (1) 4½" **Fabric J** square in (3) rows of (3) as shown. Sew the units in rows, press the seams in opposite directions, then sew the rows together. Press the seams in one direction. Repeat to make (2) 12½" blocks B (**Fig. 3**).

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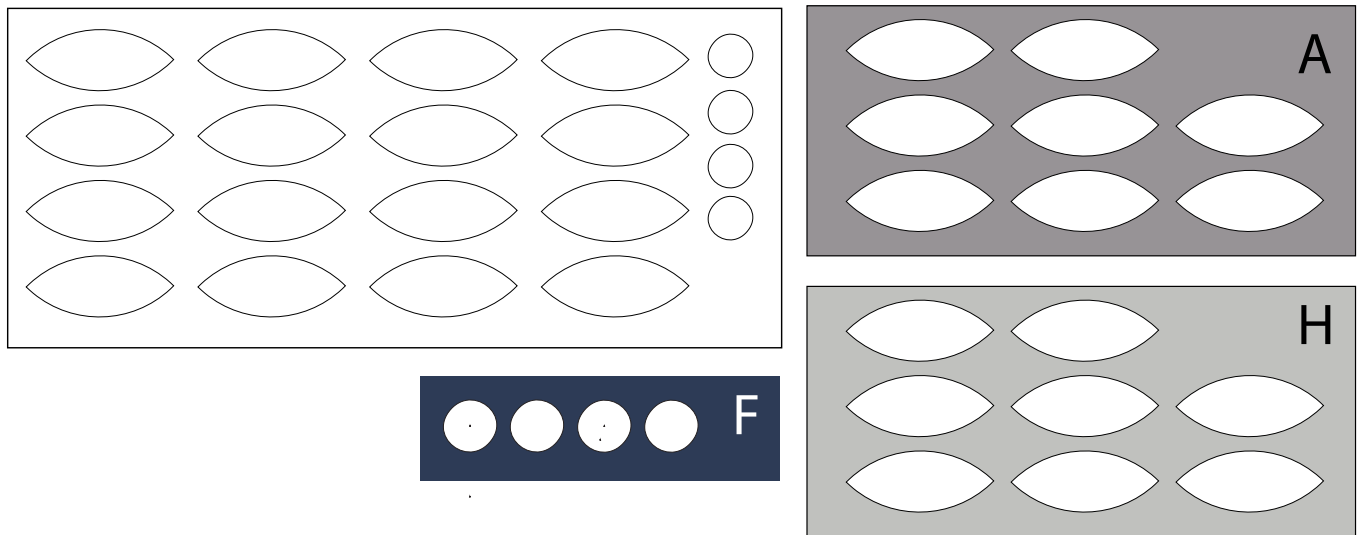
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CORNER BLOCK

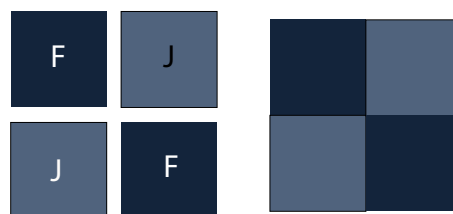
5. Place the orange peel and circle shapes onto a lightbox or windowpane. Layer the fusible web onto them and trace the orange peel (16) times and the circle (4) times with at least $\frac{1}{4}$ " space between shapes. Cut each shape $\frac{1}{8}$ " outside the outline and fuse to the wrong side of the fabrics: (8) orange peels each on **Fabrics A** and **H**, and (4) circles on **Fabric F**. Cut on the outline and remove the paper backing (**Fig. 4**).

6. Arrange (2) $6\frac{1}{2}$ " squares each of **Fabrics F** and **J** to make a 4-patch as shown. Sew the squares in rows, press the seams in opposite directions, then sew the rows together. Press the seam open. Repeat to make (4) $12\frac{1}{2}$ " units (**Fig. 5**).

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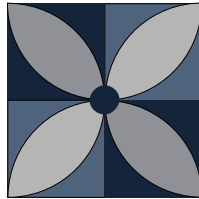
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7. Position the appliqué shapes on the 4-patches as shown: the **Fabric A** orange peels on the **Fabric F** squares, and the **Fabric H** orange peels on the **Fabric J** squares. Add a **Fabric F** circle to the center. Fuse them according to the manufacturer's instructions. Machine appliqué using matching thread and your favorite stitch. Make (4) 12½" corner blocks (**Fig. 6**).

QUILT TOP ASSEMBLY

Note: Follow the Quilt Layout Diagram (page 9) while assembling the quilt top.

8. For border 1, sew the (5) 1½" **Fabric K** strips together end to end using diagonal seams. Cut (2) 50½" strips. Sew one strip to each side of the 40½" x 50½" **Fabric L** rectangle and press the seams toward the borders. Cut (2) border strips to 42½" and sew one to the top and the other to the bottom. Press the seams toward the borders.
9. For border 2, sew the (6) 2½" **Fabric D** strips together end to end using diagonal seams. Cut (2) 52½" strips and sew one strip to each side of the quilt. Press the seams toward the borders. Cut (2) border strips to 46½" and sew one to the top and the other to the bottom. Press the seams toward the borders.
10. Repeat step 9 with the (6) 1½" **Fabric F** strips to make and add border 3. Use (2) 56½" borders for the sides and (2) 48½" borders for the top and bottom.
11. For border 4, sew the (3) 1½" **Fabric C** strips together end to end using diagonal seams. Cut (2) border strips to 48½" and sew one to the top and the other to the bottom. Press the seams toward the borders. The quilt measures 48½" x 60½" to this point.
12. For border 5, arrange two rows of five blocks each: (4) Blocks A and (1) Block B, noting placement and orientation. Sew the blocks together, press the seams in one direction, and sew one border row to each side of the quilt center. Press the seams toward the quilt center.
13. Repeat step 12 to make two rows of (4) Blocks A and (2) Corner Blocks. Sew one border row to the top and one to the bottom of the quilt center. Press as before.

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FINISHING

14. Sew together the (9) 2½" **Fabric F** binding strips end to end using diagonal seams. Press the seams open. Press the binding strip in half with the wrong sides together.
15. Layer the backing (wrong side up), batting, and quilt top (right side up). Baste the layers together and quilt as desired. Trim excess batting and backing even with the top of the quilt.
16. Leaving an 8" tail of binding and beginning along an edge of the quilt top, match the raw edges of the binding to the raw edges of the quilt. Sew the binding to the outside edge around all four sides and miter corners. Stop sewing approximately 12" from where you started and backstitch.
17. Lay both loose ends of the binding flat along the quilt edge. Where these two loose ends meet, fold them back onto themselves and press to form a crease. Using this crease as your stitching line, sew the two open ends of the binding together, with the right sides matching. Trim the seam to ¼" and press it open. Finish sewing the binding to the quilt.
18. Turn the binding over the raw edge to the back of the quilt and hand or machine stitch in place.

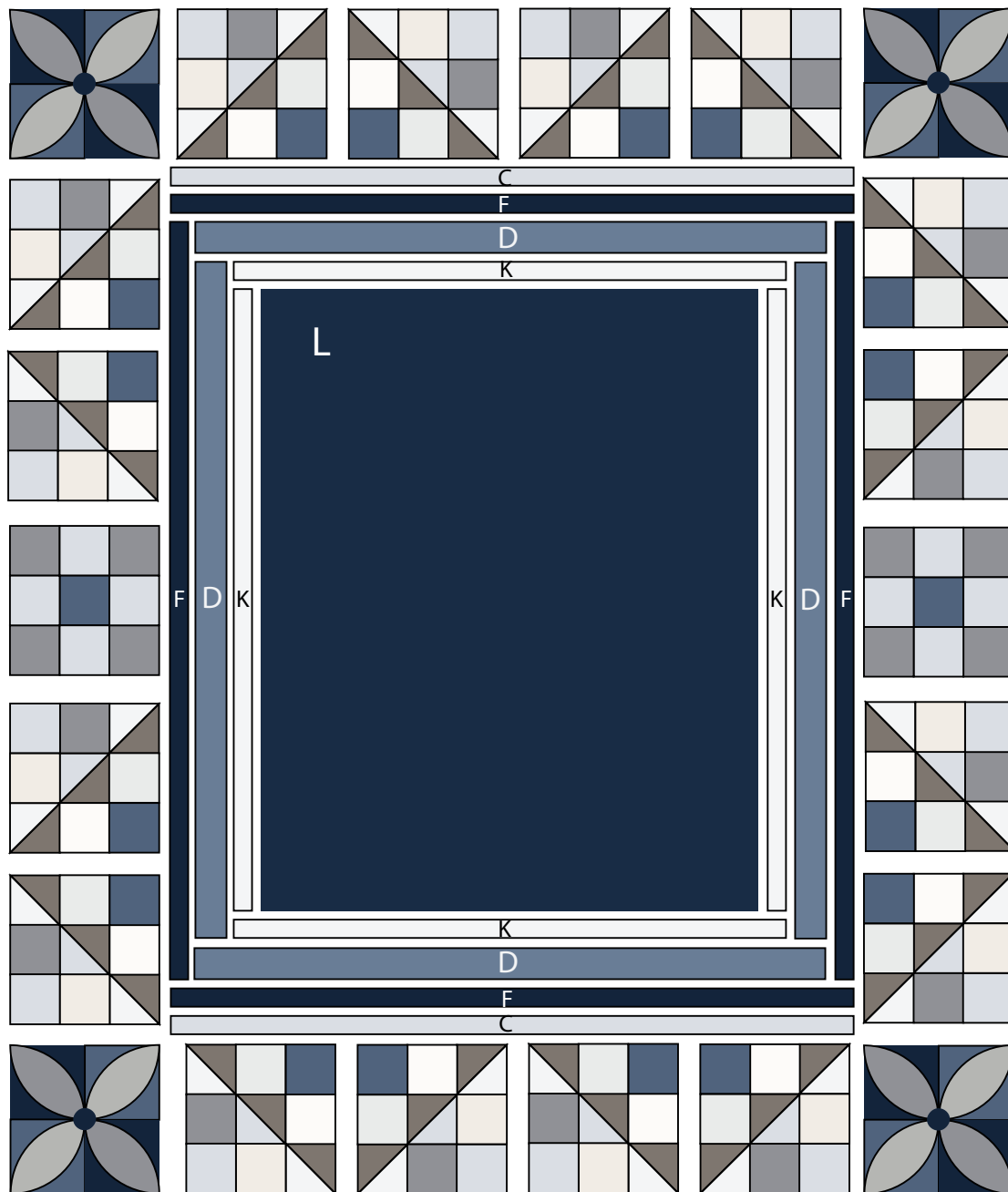
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Quilt Layout

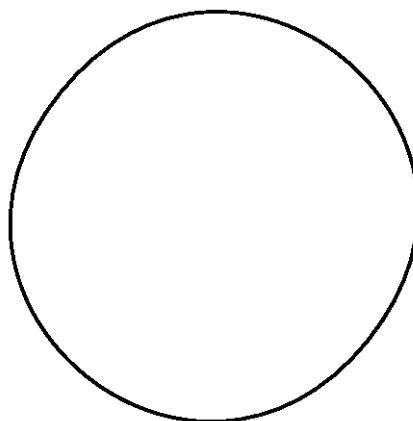
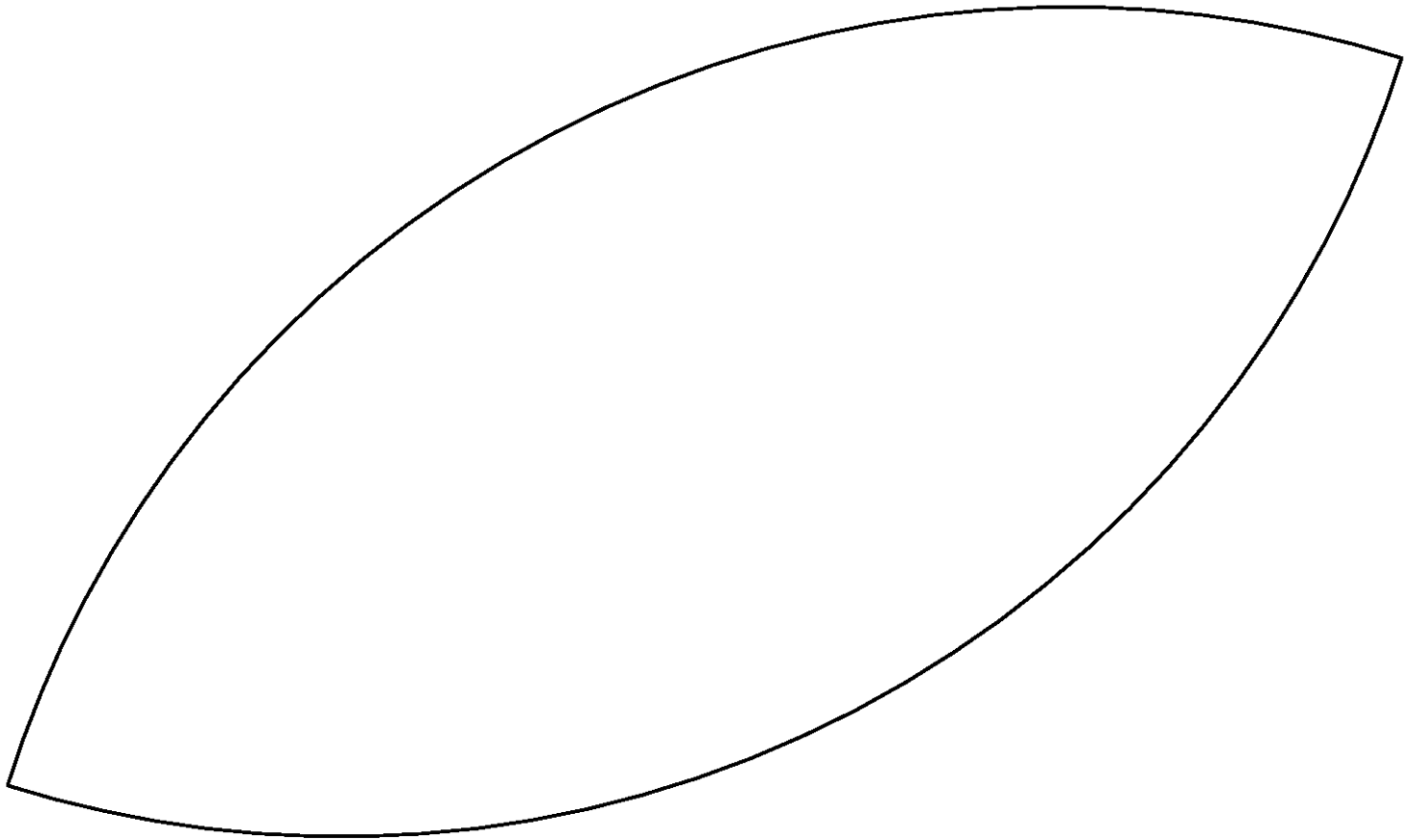
