(D) Motifs Toss	Matcha	8978-61	$\frac{1}{2}$ yard (0.46m)
(E) Raindrops	Sky	8982-17	$\frac{5}{8}$ yard (0.57m)
(F) Stars Toss	Ocean	8984-72*	$\frac{7}{8}$ yard (0.80m)

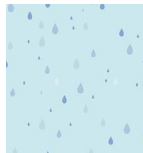

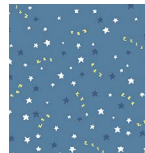

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Cutting Instructions

Notes:

- Please make sure to check *studiofabrics.net* for pattern updates prior to starting the project.
- Strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvedge to selvedge unless otherwise noted.

Fabric A, cut:

Trim book pages into (12) squares $\frac{1}{8}$ " outside the book page edges.

*This is approximately $8\frac{1}{8}$ ", but size is flexible as blocks will be trimmed to fit at the end of step 2.

Fabric B, cut:

(6) $4\frac{1}{2}$ x WOF for border 4

Fabric C, cut:

(4) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF for border 2

Fabric D, cut:

(5) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF for border 3

Fabric E:

(9) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF

Set aside (4) strips for border 1

From the remaining strips, subcut:

(3) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 28" sashing rectangles

(8) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 9" sashing rectangles

(2) 2" x WOF; subcut (24) 2" squares

Fabric F, cut:

(1) 9" x WOF; subcut:

(12) 2" x 9" rectangles

(8) 2" x 8" rectangles

(1) 2" x WOF; subcut

(4) 2" x 8" rectangles for a total of (12)

(6) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF for binding

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SEWING

Note: All seam allowances are $\frac{1}{4}$ " (0.64cm). Sew pieces with right sides together. Press seam allowances open unless otherwise indicated.

1. Sew a 2" **Fabric E** square to one end of a 2" x 8" **Fabric F** rectangle. Press the seam toward the square. Sew the strip to the right side of a **Fabric A** square as shown. Press the seam away from the center. Trim any excess **Fabric F** flush with the edge of **Fabric A** (**Fig. 1**).

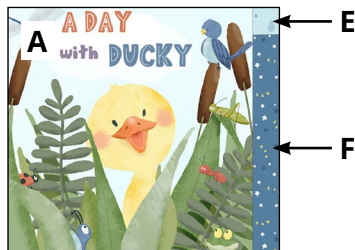

2. Sew a 2" **Fabric E** square to a 2" x 9" **Fabric F** rectangle as before. With the **Fabric E** square flush with the edge of **Fabric A**, sew the strip to the bottom of the step 1 **Fabric A** square as shown and press. Place a ruler on the edges of **Fabric A** and trim off excess border fabric to make a 9" block. Repeat to make (12) 9" blocks (**Fig. 2**).

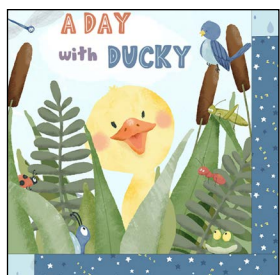

QUILT TOP ASSEMBLY

Note: Follow the Quilt Layout Diagram (page 6) while assembling the quilt top.

3. Referring to the quilt image for block placement, lay out (4) rows with (3) blocks and (2) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 9" **Fabric E** sashing rectangles. Sew the blocks and sashing together in each row. Press the seams toward the sashing.
4. Arrange the (3) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 28" **Fabric E** sashing rectangles between the block rows. Sew the block and horizontal sashing rows together. Press the seams toward the sashing.
5. For border 1, measure the vertical length of the quilt top through the center and trim (2) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " **Fabric E** strips to that length. Sew one strip to each side of the quilt top and press the seams toward the borders. Measure the width of the quilt top through the center. Cut (2) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " **Fabric E** strips to that length and sew one to the top and one to the bottom. Press the seams toward the borders.
6. For border 2, measure the vertical length of the quilt top through the center and cut two $2\frac{1}{2}$ " **Fabric C** border strips to that length. Sew one strip to each side of the quilt top and press the seams toward the borders. Measure the width of the quilt top through the center. Cut two $2\frac{1}{2}$ " **Fabric C** border strips to that length and sew one to the top and one to the bottom. Press the seams toward the borders.
7. Sew together the (5) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " **Fabric D** strips end to end using diagonal seams. Repeat step 6 to measure and add border 3.

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8. Repeat step 7 with the (6) 4½" **Fabric B** strips to make and add border 4.

FINISHING

9. Sew together the (6) 2½" **Fabric F** binding strips end to end using diagonal seams. Press the seams open. Press the binding strip in half with the wrong sides together.
10. Layer the backing (wrong side up), batting, and quilt top (right side up). Baste the layers together and quilt as desired. Trim excess batting and backing even with the top of the quilt.
11. Leaving an 8" tail of binding and beginning along an edge of the quilt top, match the raw edges of the binding to the raw edges of the

quilt. Sew the binding to the outside edge around all four sides and miter corners. Stop sewing approximately 12" from where you started and backstitch.

12. Lay both loose ends of the binding flat along the quilt edge. Where these two loose ends meet, fold them back onto themselves and press to form a crease. Using this crease as your stitching line, sew the two open ends of the binding together, with the right sides matching. Trim the seam to ¼" and press it open. Finish sewing the binding to the quilt.
13. Turn the binding over the raw edge to the back of the quilt and hand or machine stitch in place.
