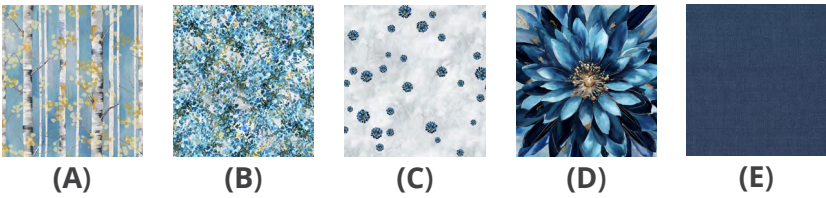

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Fabric Requirements

| (C) Tiny Flower Toss | Pearl | 8654-11 | $\frac{1}{2}$ yard (0.46m) |
| (D) Flower Power Panel | Peacock | 8658P-73 | 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ yards (1.14m) |
| (E) Peppered Cottons | Storm Cloud | Storm Cloud-87* | $\frac{1}{2}$ yard (0.46m) |

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Cutting

Notes:

- Please check www.studioefabrics.net for pattern updates prior to starting the project.
- All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvedge to selvedge edge unless otherwise noted.

Fabric A, cut:

(4) 2½" x WOF (Border 2)

Fabric B, cut:

(5) 3½" x WOF (Border 4)

Fabric C, cut:

(8) 1½" x WOF (Border 1, Border 3)

Fabric D:

Trim the panel to 30½" x 30½" as shown in the quilt photo, ensuring the center of the flower is closer to the bottom right corner of the square

Fabric E, cut

(5) 2½" x WOF (Binding)

Top Assembly

Notes:

- All seam allowances are ¼" (0.64cm). Sew pieces with right sides together (RST) using neutral or coordinating thread.
 - Press seam allowances open unless otherwise indicated.
 - Follow the Quilt Layout Diagram (page 4) while assembling the top.
1. **Border 1:** Trim (2) 1½" x WOF **Fabric C** border strips to 30½". Sew one strip to each side of the 30½" x 30½" **Fabric D** panel. Press seams toward the border. Trim (2) additional 1½" x WOF **Fabric C** strips to 32½" and sew one to the top and one to the bottom of the panel. Press seams toward the border.
 2. **Border 2:** Trim (2) 2½" x WOF **Fabric A** border strips to 32½". Sew one strip to each side of the quilt center, pressing seams toward the border. Trim (2) additional 2½" x WOF **Fabric A** strips to 36½". Sew one to the top and one to the bottom of the quilt center. Press seams toward the border.
 3. **Border 3:** Trim (2) 1½" x WOF **Fabric C** border strips to 36½". Sew one strip to each side of the quilt center, pressing seams toward the border. Trim (2) 1½" x WOF **Fabric C** strips to 38½". Sew one to the top and one to the bottom of the quilt center. Press seams toward the border.

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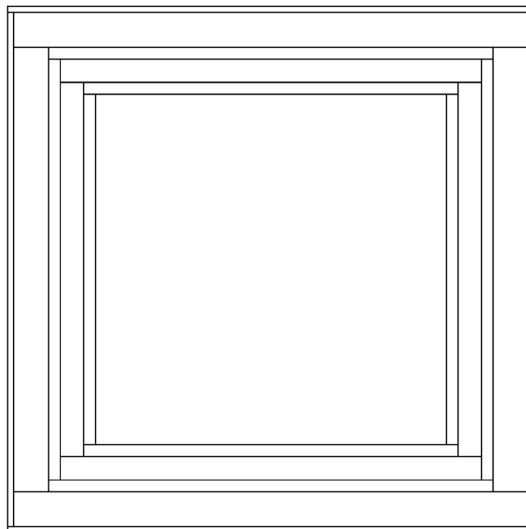
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4. **Border 4:** Trim (2) 3½" x WOF **Fabric B** border strips to 38½". Sew one strip to each side of the quilt center, pressing seams toward the border. Sew the remaining 3½" x WOF **Fabric B** strips together end to end with diagonal seams. Press seams open. Measure the width of the quilt top through the center. Cut (2) border strips that length and sew one to the top and one to the bottom of the quilt center. Press seams toward the borders.

Finishing

5. Sew together (5) 2½" x WOF **Fabric E** binding strips end to end using diagonal seams. Press seams open. Press the binding strip in half with the wrong sides together and set aside until the wall hanging is ready for binding.
6. Layer the backing (wrong side up), batting, and wall hanging top (right side up). Baste the layers together and quilt as desired. Trim excess batting and backing even with the top of the wall hanging.
7. Leaving an 8" tail of binding and beginning along an edge of the wall hanging top, matching the raw edges of the binding to the raw edges of the top. Sew the binding to the outside edge around all four sides and miter corners. Stop sewing approximately 12" from where you started and backstitch.
8. Lay both loose ends of the binding flat along the wall hanging edge. Where these two loose ends meet, fold them back onto themselves and press to form a crease. Using this crease as your stitching line, sew the two open ends of the binding together, with the right sides matching. Trim the seam to ¼" and press it open. Finish sewing the binding to the wall hanging.
9. Turn the binding over the raw edge to the back of the wall hanging and hand or machine stitch in place.
