(E) Floral Silhouette	Sky Blue	8604-17	¾ yard (0.69m)

(G) Butterfly Meadow	Pastel Multi	8609-11	¾ yard (0.69m)

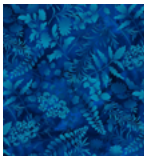

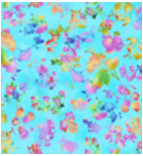

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Cutting

Notes:

- Please make sure to check www.studioefabrics.net for pattern updates prior to starting the project.
- All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvedge to selvedge edge unless otherwise noted.
- *Always measure your quilt top before cutting and sewing borders and adjust if necessary.

Fabric A, cut:

- (7) 3" x WOF; subcut
- (10) 3" x 13" strips
- (10) 3" x 10½" strips

Fabric B, cut:

- (2) 3" x WOF; subcut
- (20) 3" squares
- (7) 2½" x WOF for the binding

Fabric C, cut:

- (4) 3" x WOF; subcut
- (10) 3" x 8" strips
- (10) 3" x 5½" strips

Fabric D, cut:

- (7) 4½" x WOF. Sew the strips together end to end with 45-degree diagonal seams for borders; subcut*
- (2) 4½" x 63"
- (2) 4½" x 58½" strips
- (7) 3" x WOF; subcut
- (10) 3" x 13" strips
- (10) 3" x 10½" strips

Fabric E, cut:

- (8) 3" x WOF; subcut
- (10) 3" x 10½" strips
- (10) 3" x 8" strips
- (10) 3" x 5½" strips
- (10) 3" squares

Fabric F, cut:

- (4) 3" x WOF; subcut
- (10) 3" x 8" strips
- (10) 3" x 5½" strips

Fabric G, cut:

- (8) 3" x WOF; subcut
- (10) 3" x 10½" strips
- (10) 3" x 8" strips
- (10) 3" x 5½" strips
- (10) 3" squares

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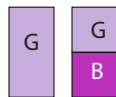
Block Assembly

Note:

- All seam allowances are $\frac{1}{4}$ " (.64cm) unless otherwise noted.
- Sew pieces right sides together.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise indicated.

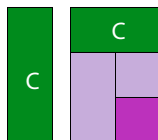
1. Sew (1) each 3" **Fabric B** and **Fabric G** squares together. Sew (1) 3" x 5½" **Fabric G** strip to the left side (**Fig. 1**).
4. Sew (1) 3" x 10½" **Fabric A** strip to top of unit from step 3. Sew (1) 3" x 13" **Fabric A** strip to left side to complete Block 1 measuring 13" square (**Fig. 4**). Make (10).

2. Sew (1) 3" x 5½" **Fabric C** strip to the top of the unit from step 1. Sew (1) 3" x 8" **Fabric C** strip to the left side (**Fig. 2**).

3. Sew (1) 3" x 8" **Fabric G** strip to the top of the unit from step 2. Sew (1) 3" x 10½" **Fabric G** strip to the left side (**Fig. 3**).

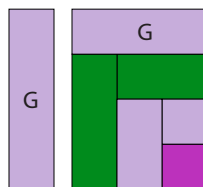

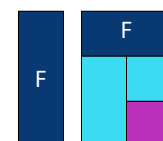
5. Sew (1) each 3" **Fabric B** and **Fabric E** squares together. Sew (1) 3" x 5½" **Fabric E** strip to the left side (**Fig. 5**).

6. Sew (1) 3" x 5½" **Fabric F** strip to the top of the unit from step 5. Sew (1) 3" x 8" **Fabric F** strip to the left side (**Fig. 6**).

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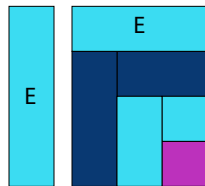
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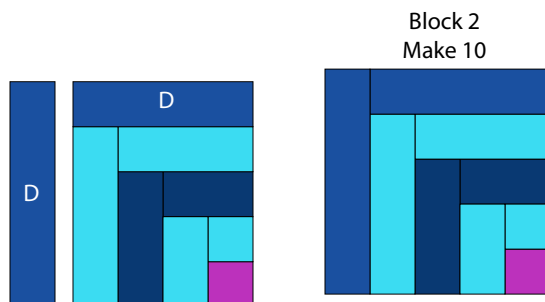
7. Sew (1) 3" x 8" **Fabric E** strip to the top of the unit from step 6. Sew (1) 3" x 10½" **Fabric E** strip to the left side (**Fig. 7**).

8. Sew (1) 3" x 10½" **Fabric D** strip to top of unit from step 7. Sew (1) 3" x 13" **Fabric D** strip to left side to complete Block 2 measuring 13" square (**Fig. 8**). Make (10).

Quilt Top Assembly

Note: Follow the Quilt Layout (page 6) while assembling the quilt top.

9. Referring to the Quilt Layout for placement and orientation, sew blocks together in (5) Rows of (4) Blocks to make the Quilt Center.
10. Sew (1) 4½" x 63" **Fabric D** strip to each side of the Quilt Center. Sew (1) 4½" x 58½" **Fabric D** strip to the top and bottom to make the quilt top which finishes at 58" x 70½".

Finishing

11. Sew together the (7) 2½" x WOF **Fabric B** binding strips end to end using diagonal seams. Press the seams open. Press the binding strip in half wrong sides together.
12. Layer the backing (wrong side up), batting, and quilt top (right side up). Baste the layers together and quilt as desired. Trim excess batting and backing even with the quilt top.
13. Leaving an 8" tail of binding and beginning along an edge of the quilt top, match raw edges of the binding to the raw edges of the quilt top. Sew the binding to the outside edge around all four sides and miter corners. Stop sewing approximately 12" from where you started and backstitch.
14. Lay both loose ends of binding flat along the quilt edge. Where these two loose ends meet, fold them back onto themselves and press to form a crease. Using this crease as your stitching line, sew the two open ends of the binding together, right sides matching. Trim seam to ¼" and press seam open. Finish sewing the binding to the quilt top.
15. Turn the binding over the raw edge to the back of the quilt and hand or machine stitch in place.

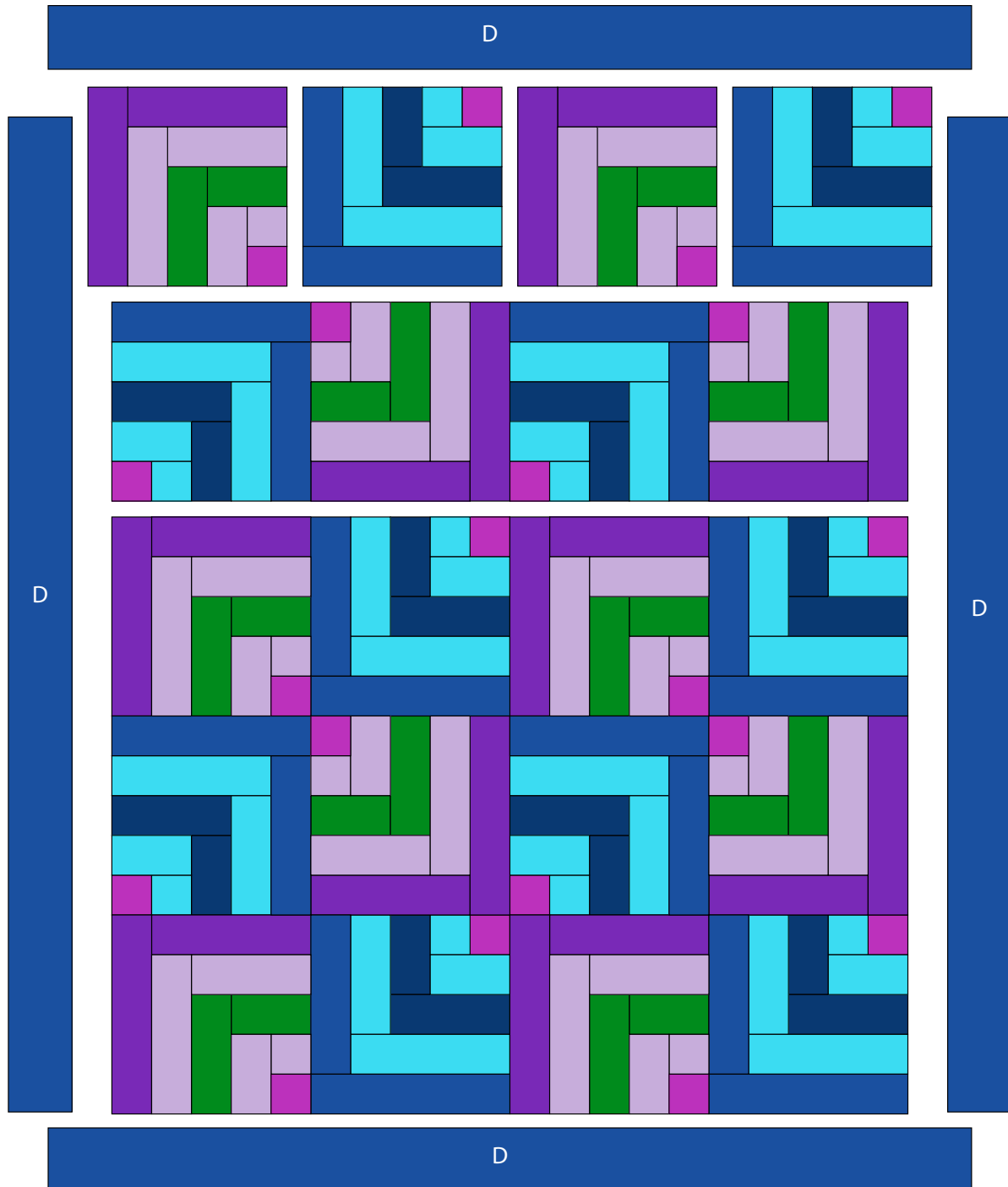
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Quilt Layout



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
