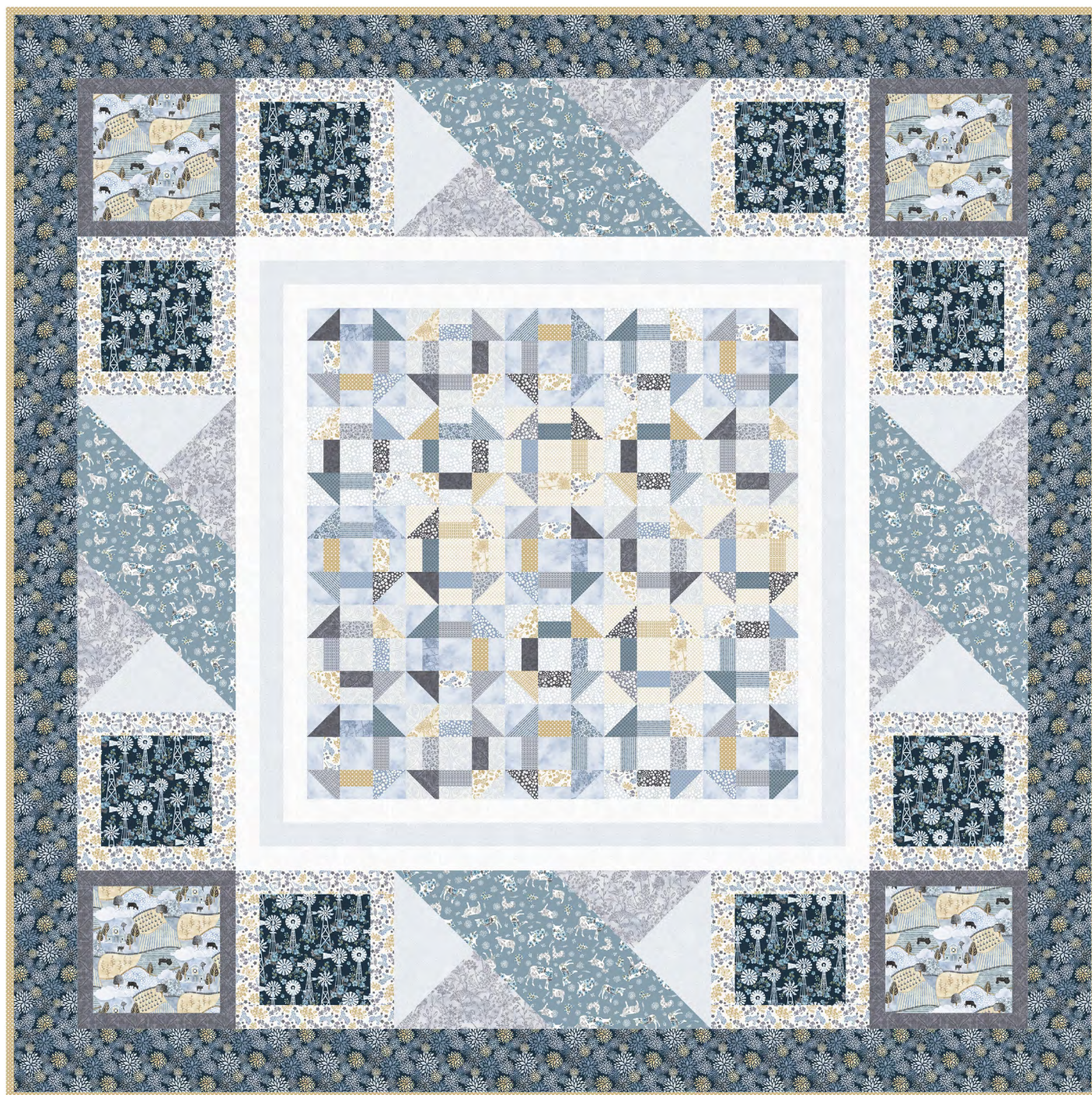

CUTTING

Notes:

- Please make sure to check www.studioefabrics.net for pattern updates prior to starting the project.
- All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

Fabric A, fussy-cut:

(1) 31½" x 31½" square

Fabric B, cut:

(1) 8½" x WOF; subcut (4) 8½" squares

Fabric C, cut:

(2) 10⅞" x WOF; subcut (4) 10⅞" squares;
cut once diagonally

Fabric D, cut:

(2) 7½" x WOF; subcut (8) 7½" squares

Fabric E, cut:

(1) 10½" x WOF; subcut
(16) 2" x 10½" rectangles
(4) 2" x 7½" rectangles
(3) 2" x WOF; subcut (12) 2" x 7½" rectangles,
total of 16

Fabric F, cut:

(8) 4½" x WOF for border 5

Fabric G, cut:

(8) 2½" x WOF for binding

Fabric H, cut:

(5) 1½" x WOF; subcut
(8) 1½" x 10½" rectangles
(8) 1½" x 8½" rectangles

Fabric I, cut:

(1) 11¼" x WOF. Subcut (2) 11¼" squares;
cut twice diagonally

Fabric J, cut:

(1) 11¼" x WOF. Subcut (2) 11¼" squares;
cut twice diagonally
(4) 2" x WOF for border 2

Fabric K, cut:

(8) 2" x WOF: (4) for border 1,
(4) for border 3

SEWING

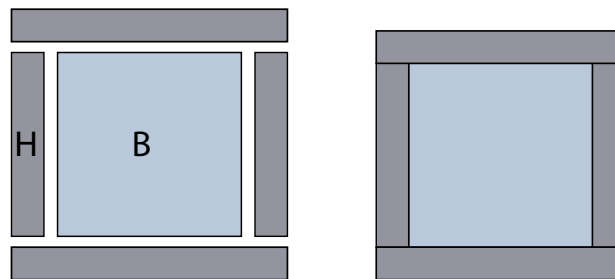
Notes:

- All seam allowances are $\frac{1}{4}$ " (0.64cm).
- Sew pieces with right sides together.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise indicated.

BLOCKS 1 AND 2

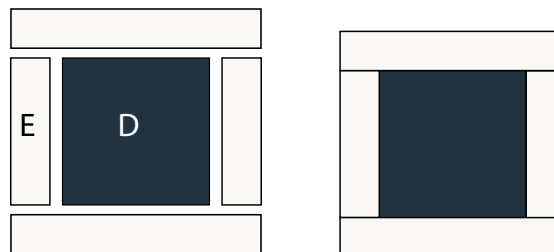
1. Sew (2) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ " **Fabric H** rectangles to opposite sides of an $8\frac{1}{2}$ " **Fabric B** square. Press the seams away from the center. Sew (2) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $10\frac{1}{2}$ " **Fabric H** rectangles to the top and bottom of the units. Press as before. Repeat to make (4) $10\frac{1}{2}$ " Blocks 1 (**Fig. 1**).

2. Repeat step 1 with the (8) $7\frac{1}{2}$ " **Fabric D** squares, (16) 2" x $7\frac{1}{2}$ " and (16) 2" x $10\frac{1}{2}$ " **Fabric E** rectangles to make (8) $10\frac{1}{2}$ " Blocks 2 (**Fig. 2**).

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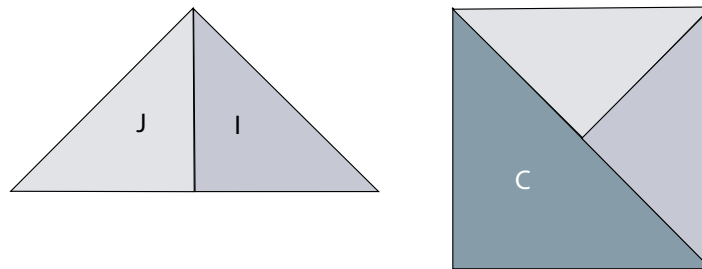

BLOCKS 3 AND 4

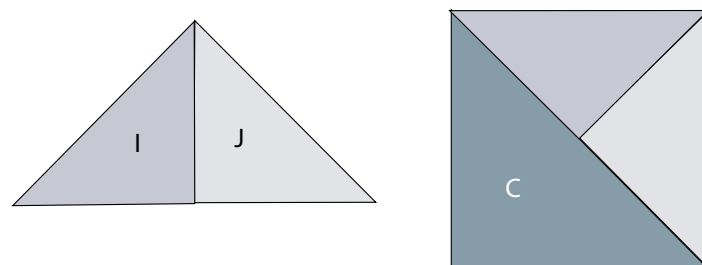
3. Sew a **Fabric I** triangle to a **Fabric J** triangle. Press the seam to the darker fabric. Sew a **Fabric C** triangle to the unit and press the seam toward the last addition. Repeat to make (4) 10½" Blocks 3 (**Fig. 3**).

4. Repeat step 3 with the remaining **Fabric I**, **Fabric J** and **Fabric C** triangles, except sew the **Fabric J** triangle to the **Fabric I** triangle as shown. Repeat to make (4) 10½" Blocks 4 (**Fig. 4**).

QUILT TOP ASSEMBLY

Note: Follow the Quilt Layout Diagram (page 7) while assembling the quilt top.

5. For border 1, trim (2) 2" **Fabric K** border strips to 31½". Sew one strip to either side of the 31½" x 31½" **Fabric A** square and press the seams toward the border. Trim (2) more **Fabric K** strips to 34½" and sew one to the top and one to the bottom. Press the seams toward the border.

6. For border 2, trim (2) 2" **Fabric J** strips to 34½". Sew one strip to each side of the quilt top and press the seams toward the borders. Trim (2) **Fabric J** strips to 37½" and sew one to the top and one to the bottom. Press the seams toward the borders.
7. For border 3, trim (2) 2" **Fabric K** strips to 37½". Sew one strip to each side of the quilt top and press the seams toward the borders. Trim (2) **Fabric K** strips to 40½" and sew one to the top and one to the bottom. Press the seams as before. The quilt measures 40½" square to this point.
8. For border 4, refer to the quilt image and diagram to arrange (2) Blocks 2 and 2 Blocks 3 as shown – note the fabric orientation. Sew them together and press. Make (2) vertical rows. Sew to opposite sides of the quilt center and press the seams toward the border. Arrange (2) Blocks 1, (2) Blocks 4, and (2) Blocks 1 in a row, sew them together, and press. Make (2) horizontal rows. Sew to the top and bottom of the quilt center. Press as before.
9. For border 5, sew (8) 4½" **Fabric F** border strips together end to end using diagonal seams. Measure the vertical length of the quilt top through the center and cut (2) border strips that length. Sew (1) strip to each side of the quilt top and press the seams toward the borders. Measure the width of the quilt top through the center. Cut (2) **Fabric F** border strips to that length and sew one to the top and one to the bottom. Press the seams toward the borders.

FINISHING

10. Sew together the (8) 2½" **Fabric G** binding strips end to end using diagonal seams. Press the seams open. Press the binding strip in half with the wrong sides together.
11. Layer the backing (wrong side up), batting, and quilt top (right side up). Baste the layers together and quilt as desired. Trim excess batting and backing even with the top of the quilt.
12. Leaving an 8" tail of binding and beginning along an edge of the quilt top, matching the raw edges of the binding to the raw edges of the quilt. Sew the binding to the outside edge around all four sides and miter corners. Stop sewing approximately 12" from where you started and backstitch.
13. Lay both loose ends of the binding flat along the quilt edge. Where these two loose ends meet, fold them back onto themselves and press to form a crease. Using this crease as your stitching line, sew the two open ends of the binding together, with the right sides matching. Trim the seam to ¼" and press it open. Finish sewing the binding to the quilt.
14. Turn the binding over the raw edge to the back of the quilt and hand or machine stitch in place.

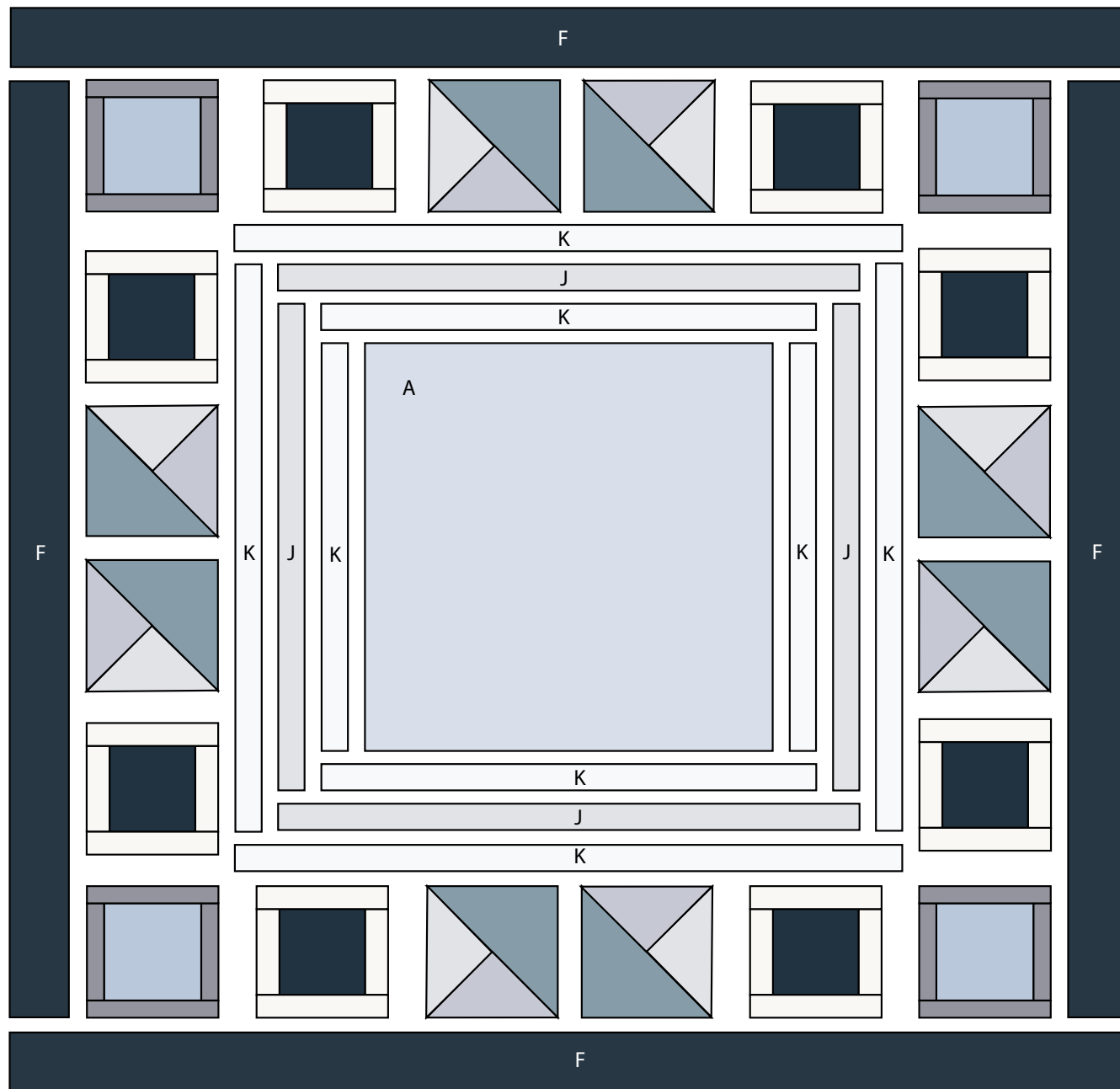
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Mosaic Quilt
