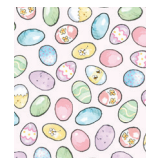

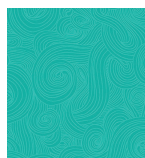

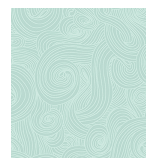

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## Cutting Instructions

### Notes:

- Please check [www.studiofabrics.net](http://www.studiofabrics.net) for pattern updates prior to starting the project.
- All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvedge to selvedge edge unless otherwise noted.

### Fabric A, cut:

- (4) 4½" x WOF; sew together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 4½" x 66½"
- (3) 4½" x WOF; sew together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 4½" x 58½"

### Fabric B, cut:

- (4) Eggs

### Fabric C, cut:

- (4) 2½" x WOF; sew together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2½" x 60½"
- (3) 2½" x WOF; sew together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2½" x 48½"

### Fabric D, cut:

- (10) 2½" x WOF; subcut  
(144) 2½" squares
- (4) 2" x WOF; subcut  
(24) 2" x 6½"
- (6) 2" x WOF; subcut  
(24) 2" x 9½"

### Fabric E, cut:

- (3) 2½" x WOF; sew together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2½" x 44½"
- (2) 2½" x 28½"

### Fabric F, cut:

- (1) 2½" x 28½"

### Fabric G, cut:

- (2) 2½" x 28½"

### Fabric H, cut:

- (1) 6½" x WOF; subcut  
(4) 6½" squares

### Fabric I, fussy cut:

- (12) 6½" squares each centered on a book block

### Fabric J, cut:

- (5) 2½" x WOF; subcut  
(36) 2½" x 4½"
- (4) 1½" x WOF; subcut  
(8) 1½" x 6½"
- (8) 1½" x 8½"
- (2) 1½" x WOF

### Fabric K, cut:

- (4) 2½" x WOF; subcut  
(36) 2½" x 4½"
- (4) 1½" x WOF

## Fabric L, cut:

(10) 1½" x 28½"

(5) 1½" x WOF; sew together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (4) 1½" x 44½"

(4) 1½" x WOF; sew together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1½" x 64½"

(3) 1½" x WOF; sew together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1½" x 50½"

## Fabric M, cut:

(2) 1½" x WOF

## Fabric N, cut:

(7) 2½" x WOF for the binding

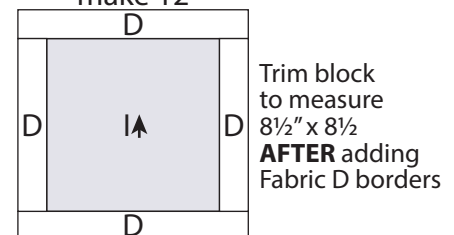
## Sewing

- Sew using a ¼" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise indicated. Press seams towards the darker fabric, unless otherwise indicated.
- The arrows in the figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components.

1. Sew (1) 2" x 6½" **Fabric D** strip to each side of (1) 6½" **Fabric I** square. Sew (1) 2" x 9½" **Fabric D** strip to the top and bottom of the **Fabric I** square to make (1) Block One square (**Fig. 1**). **Trim the block to measure 8½" x 8½"**. Repeat to make an additional (11) Block One squares.

2. Sew (1) 1½" x WOF **Fabric J** strip to the left side of (1) 1½" x WOF **Fabric K** strip to make (1) Strip Set 1 (**Fig. 2**). Repeat to make a second Strip Set 1.
3. From the (2) Strip Set 1's cut (32) 1½" x 2½" Unit 1 strips (**Fig. 3**).

- Sew (1) 1½" x WOF **Fabric K** strip to the left side of (1) 1½" x WOF **Fabric M** strip to make (1) Strip Set 2 (**Fig. 4**). Repeat to make a second Strip Set 2.
- From the (2) Strip Set 2's cut (32) 1½" x 2½" Unit 1 strips (**Fig. 5**).

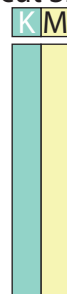

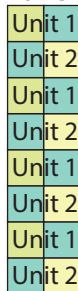

- Sew together (4) Unit 1 strips and (4) Unit 2 strips, alternating them from top to bottom, to make (1) 2½" x 8½" Block Two strip (**Fig. 6**). Repeat to make an additional (7) Block Two strips.

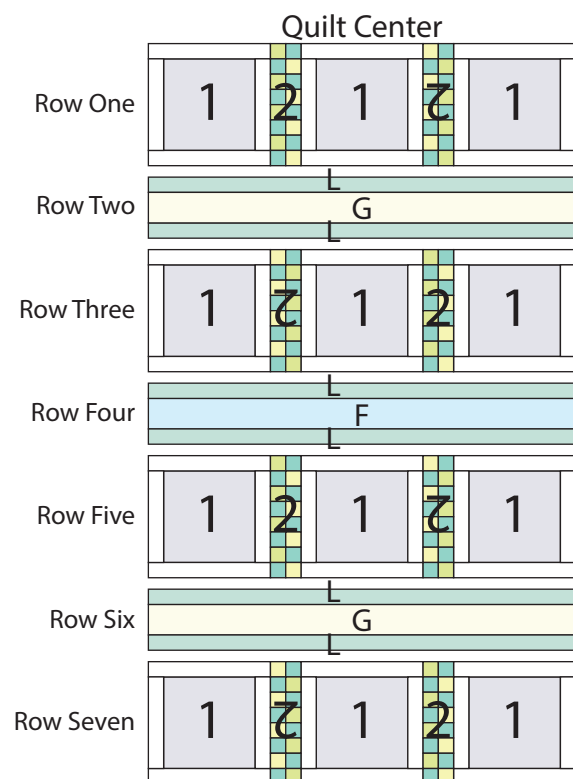

- Paying attention to the block orientations, sew together (3) Block One squares, (2) Block Two strips, alternating them from left to right, to make Row One (**Fig. 7**). Repeat to make Row Three, Row Five and Row Seven.
- Sew (1) 1½" x 28½" **Fabric L** strip to the top and bottom of (1) 2½" x 28½" **Fabric G** strip to make Row Two (**Fig. 7**). Repeat to make Row Six.
- Sew (1) 1½" x 28½" **Fabric L** strip to the top and bottom of (1) 2½" x 28½" **Fabric F** strip to make Row Four (**Fig. 7**).
- Sew together the (7) pieced Rows, lengthwise and in numerical order from top to bottom, to make the 28½" x 44½" Quilt Center (**Fig. 7**).

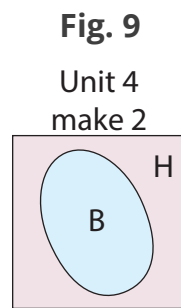
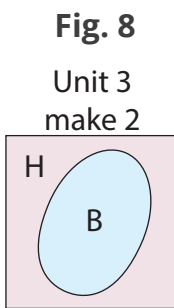
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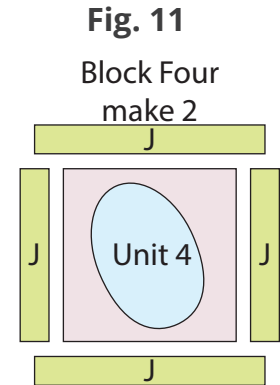
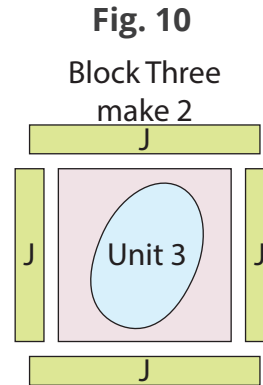
# Easter Celebration Quilt

11. Following the manufacturer's instructions, trace the listed number of each template onto the paper side of the fusible web. Roughly cut out each template about 1/8" outside the drawn lines.
12. Press each template onto the wrong side of the fabrics as listed on the templates. Cut out each template on the drawn lines.
13. Arrange and press (1) **Fabric B** Egg onto (1) 6½" **Fabric H** square (**Fig. 8**).
14. Finish the raw edges of the egg with a decorative stitch such as a buttonhole or satin stitch to make (1) 6½" Unit 3 square (**Fig. 8**).
15. Repeat Steps 13-14 to make a second Unit 3 square.
16. Repeat Steps 13-14 and refer to **Figure 9** for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make (2) 6½" Unit 4 squares.

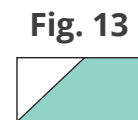
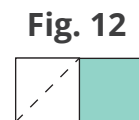


17. Sew (1) 1½" x 6½" **Fabric J** strip to each side of (1) Unit 3 square. Sew (1) 1½" x 8½" **Fabric J** strip to the top and bottom of the Unit 3 square to make (1) 8½" Block Three square (**Fig. 10**). Repeat to make a second Block Three square.
18. Sew (1) 1½" x 6½" **Fabric J** strip to each side of (1) Unit 4 square. Sew (1) 1½" x 8½" **Fabric J** strip to the top and bottom of the Unit 4 square to make (1) 8½" Block Four

square (**Fig. 11**). Repeat to make a second Block Four square.



19. Place (1) 2½" **Fabric D** square on the left side of (1) 2½" x 4½" **Fabric K** strip, RST (**Fig. 12**). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (**Fig. 12**). Flip open the triangle formed and press (**Fig. 13**). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a ¼" seam allowance.



20. Place another 2½" **Fabric D** square on the right side of the 2½" x 4½" **Fabric K** strip, RST (**Fig. 14**). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (**Fig. 14**). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a ¼" seam allowance to make (1) 2½" x 4½" Unit 5 strip (**Fig. 15**).
21. Repeat Steps 19-20 to make an additional (35) Unit 5 strips.
22. Repeat Steps 19-20 and refer to Figure 16 for fabric identification, placement and seam direction to make (36) 2½" x 4½" Unit 6 strips.

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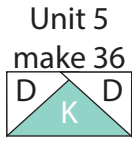
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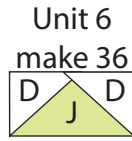

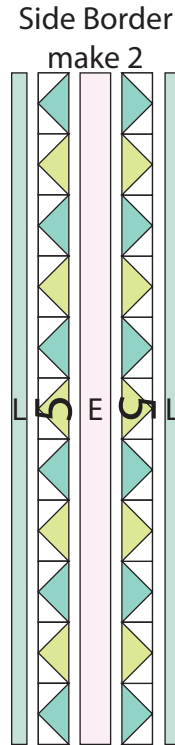

23. Sew together (6) Unit 5 strips and (5) Unit 6 strips, end to end and alternating them from left to right, to make (1) 2½" x 44½" Block Five strip (**Fig. 17** below). Repeat to make an additional (3) Block Five strips.
24. Sew together (4) Unit 6 strips and (3) Unit 5 strips, end to end and alternating them from left to right, to make (1) 2½" x 28½" Block Six strip (**Fig. 18**). Repeat to make an additional (3) Block Six strips.

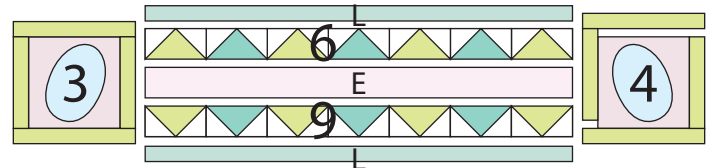

25. Sew together (2) 1½" x 44½" **Fabric L** strips, (2) Block Five strips and (1) 2½" x 44½" **Fabric E** strip lengthwise as shown to make (1) 8½" x 44½" Side Border (**Fig. 19**). Repeat to make a second Side Border.
26. Sew together (2) 1½" x 28½" **Fabric L** strips, (2) Block Six strips and (1) 2½" x 28½" **Fabric E** strip lengthwise as shown. Sew (1) Block Three square to the left side and (1) Block Four the right side of the newly sewn strip to make (1) 8½" x 44½" Top Border (**Fig. 20**). Repeat to make the Bottom Border.

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## Quilt Top Assembly

Follow the Quilt Layout (Page 9) while assembling the quilt top.

27. Sew (1) Side Border to each side of the Quilt Center. Sew the Top Border and Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Quilt Center.
28. Sew (1) 2½" x 60½" **Fabric C** strip to each side of the Quilt Center. Sew (1) 2½" x 48½" **Fabric C** strip to the top and bottom of the Quilt Center.
29. Sew (1) 1½" x 64½" **Fabric L** strip to each side of the Quilt Center. Sew (1) 1½" x 50½" **Fabric L** strip to the top and bottom of the Quilt Center.
30. Sew (1) 4½" x 66½" **Fabric A** strip to each side of the Quilt Center. Sew (1) 4½" x 58½" **Fabric A** strip to the top and bottom of the Quilt Center to complete the quilt top which should measure 58½" x 74½".

## Layering, Quilting and Finishing

31. Layer the backing (wrong side up), batting, and quilt top (right side up). Baste the layers together and quilt as desired. Trim excess batting and backing even with the top of the quilt.

## Binding

32. Sew together (7) 2½" x WOF **Fabric N** binding strips end to end with diagonal seams. Press the seams open. Press the binding strip in half wrong sides together.
33. Leaving an 8" tail of binding and beginning along an edge of the quilt top, match raw edges of the binding to the raw edges of the quilt top. Sew the binding to the outside

edge around all four sides and miter corners. Stop sewing approximately 12" from where you started and backstitch.

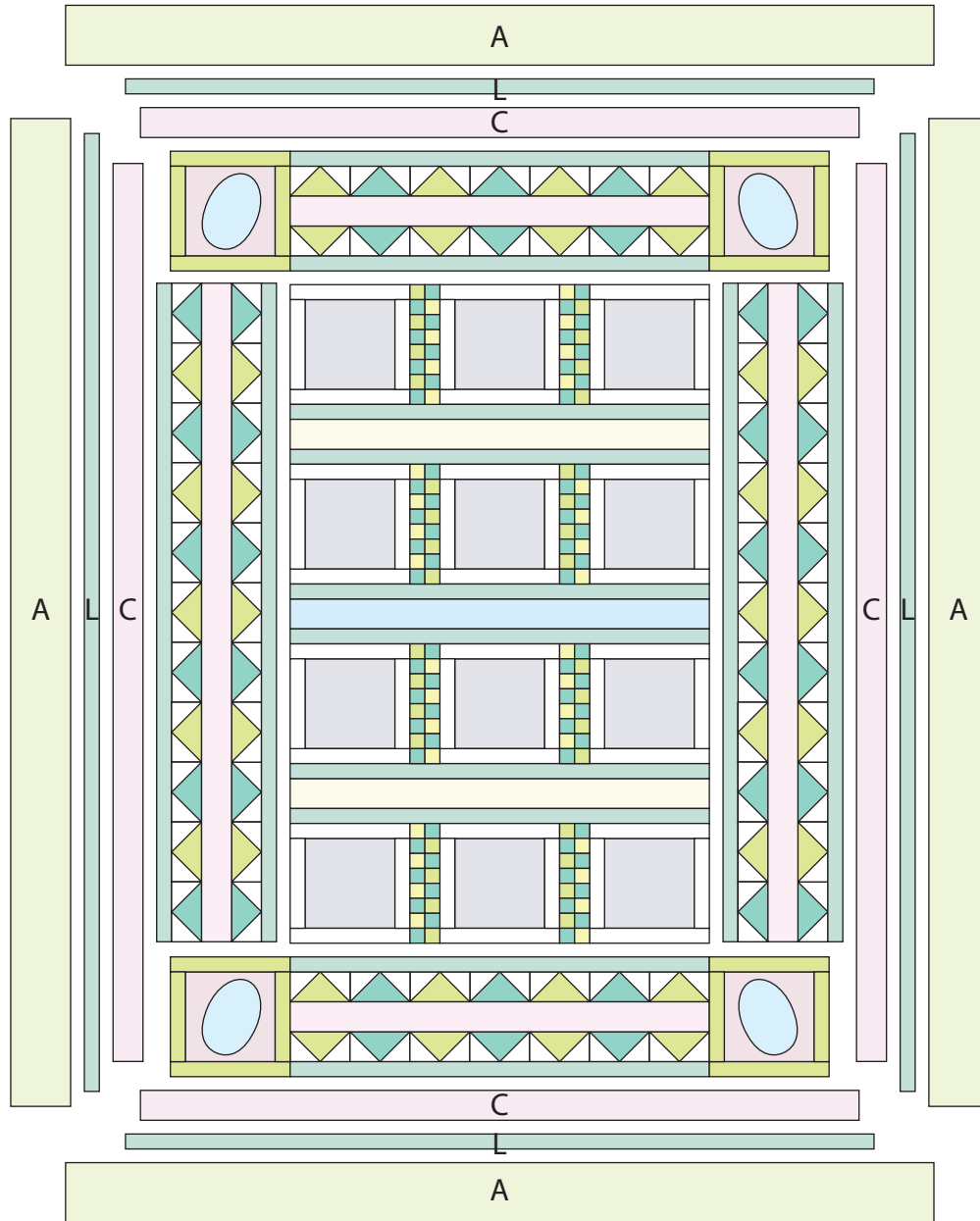
34. Lay both loose ends of binding flat along the quilt edge. Where these two loose ends meet, fold them back onto themselves and press to form a crease. Using this crease as your stitching line, sew the two open ends of the binding together, right sides matching. Trim seam to ¼" and press seam open. Finish sewing the binding to the quilt top.
35. Turn the binding over the raw edge to the back of the quilt and hand or machine stitch in place.

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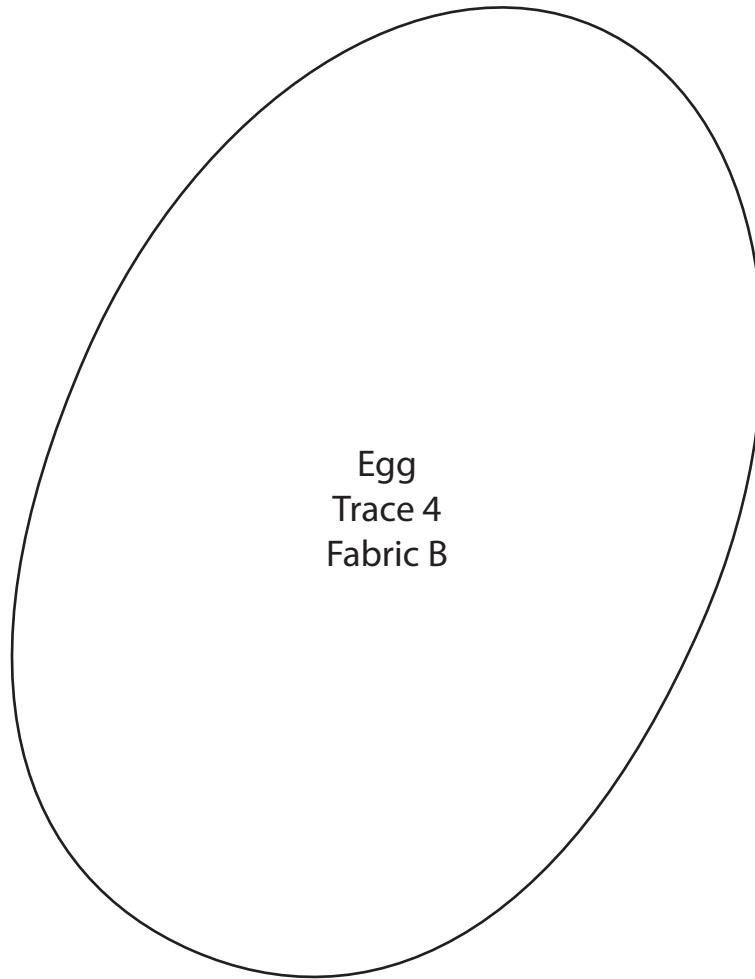
## Quilt Layout
