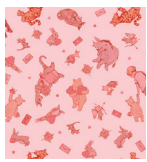

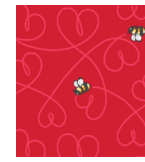

- All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvedge to selvedge edge unless otherwise noted.

Fabric A, cut:

(7) Small Hearts

Fabric B, cut:

(2) 10½" x WOF; subcut
(6) 10½" squares

(7) Small Hearts

Fabric D, cut:

(2) 10½" x WOF; subcut
(6) 10½" squares
(4) 1½" x WOF; subcut
(12) 1½" x 10½"

Fabric E, cut:

(3) 2½" x WOF; sew together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2½" x 53½"
(2) 2½" x 40½", piece as needed.

Fabric F, cut:

(3) 2½" x WOF; sew together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2½" x 46½"
(3) 1½" x WOF; sew together end to end with

diagonal seams and cut (2) 1½" x 56½"
(3) 1½" x WOF; sew together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1½" x 57½"
(4) 1½" x WOF; sew together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1½" x 69½"
(11) 1½" x WOF; subcut
(31) 1½" x 12½"
(6) 1 ½" x WOF; subcut
(46) 1½" x 4½"

Fabric G, cut:

(7) Small Hearts

Fabric H, cut:

(4) 1½" x WOF; subcut
(12) 1½" x 10½"
(4) 1½" x WOF; subcut
(12) 1½" x 12½"
(7) Small Hearts

Fabric I, cut:

(1) 2½" x WOF; subcut
(4) 2½" squares
(1) 1½" x WOF; subcut
(20) 1½" squares
(4) Small Hearts
(7) 2½" x WOF for the binding

Fabric J, fussy cut:

(12) Large Hearts each centered on a block

Fabric K,

(6) 4½" x WOF; subcut
(46) 4½" squares

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Sewing

- Sew using a 1/4" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise indicated. Press seams towards the darker fabric, unless otherwise indicated.
- The arrows in the figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components.

1. Following the manufacturer's instructions, trace the listed number of each template onto the paper side of the fusible web. Roughly cut out each template about 1/8" outside the drawn lines.
2. Press each template onto the wrong side of the fabrics as listed on the templates. Cut out each template on the drawn lines.
3. Arrange and press (1) **Fabric J** large heart onto (1) 10 1/2" **Fabric D** square (**Fig. 1**).
4. Finish the raw edges of the heart with a decorative stitch such as a buttonhole or satin stitch to make (1) 10 1/2" Unit 1 square (**Fig. 1**).
5. Repeat Steps 4-5 to make an additional (5) Unit 1 squares.
6. Repeat Steps 4-5 and refer to **Figure 2** for fabric identification and placement to make (6) 10 1/2" Unit 2 squares.

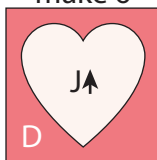
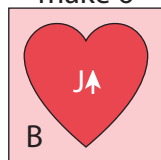

7. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 10 1/2" **Fabric H** strip to each side of (1) Unit 1 square. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 12 1/2" **Fabric H** strip to the top and bottom of the Unit 1 square to make (1) 12 1/2" Block One square (**Fig. 3**). Repeat to make an additional (5) Block One squares.
8. Repeat Step 7 and refer to **Figure 4** for fabric/unit identification, placement and orientation to make (6) 10 1/2" Unit 2 squares.

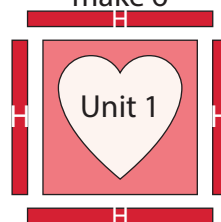
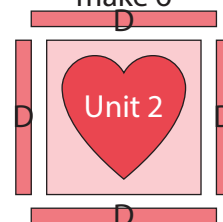

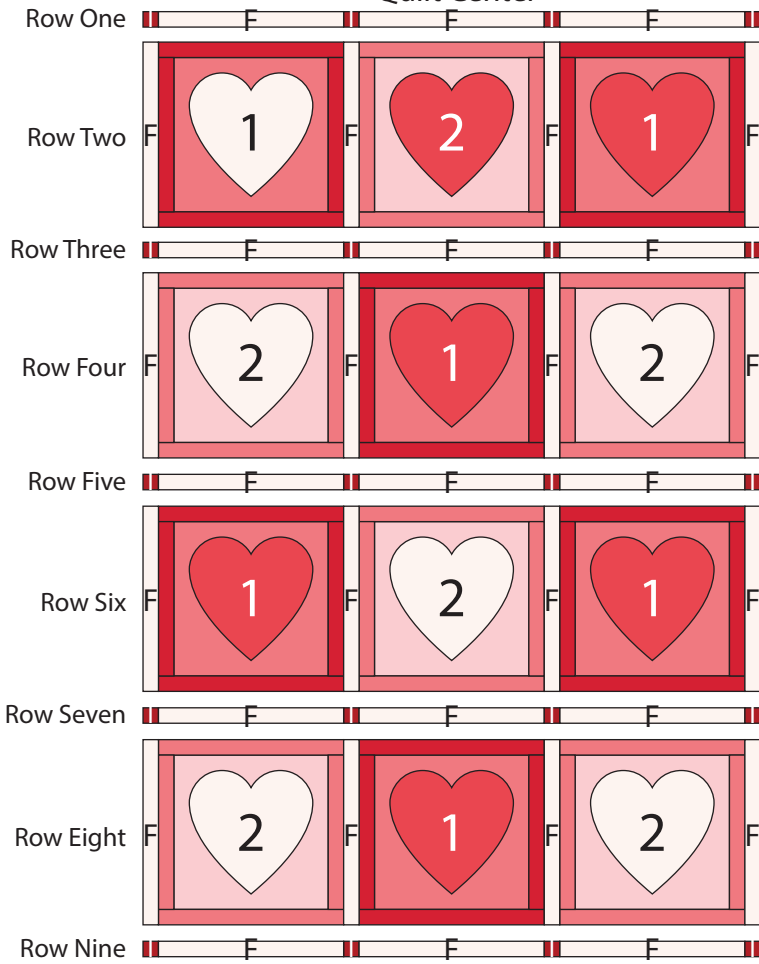
9. Sew together (4) 1 1/2" **Fabric I** squares and (3) 1 1/2" x 12 1/2" **Fabric F** strips, end to end and alternating them from left to right, to make Row One (**Fig. 5**) Repeat to make Row Three, Row Five, Row Seven and Row Nine.
10. Sew together (4) 1 1/2" x 12 1/2" **Fabric F** strips, (2) Block One squares and (1) Block Two square as shown to make Row Two (**Fig. 5**). Repeat to make Row Six.
11. Sew together (4) 1 1/2" x 12 1/2" **Fabric F** strips, (2) Block Two squares and (1) Block One square as shown to make Row Four (**Fig. 5**). Repeat to make Row Eight.
12. Sew together the (9) pieced Rows, lengthwise and in numerical order from top to bottom, to make the 40 1/2" x 53 1/2" Quilt Center (**Fig. 5**).

13. Arrange and press (1) **Fabric I** small heart onto (1) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " **Fabric K** square (**Fig. 6**).
14. Finish the raw edges of the heart with a decorative stitch such as a buttonhole or satin stitch to make (1) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Block Three square (**Fig. 6**).
15. Repeat Steps 13-14 to make an additional (3) Block Three squares.

16. Repeat Steps 13-14 and refer to **Figures 7-12** for fabric identification and placement to make the indicated number of block squares for Block Four through Block Nine.

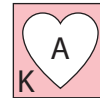

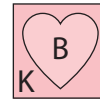

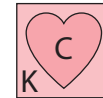

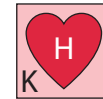


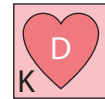

17. Sew together (13) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " **Fabric F** strips and (12) assorted small block squares as shown to make the $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $61\frac{1}{2}$ " Left Side Border (**Fig. 13**). Repeat to make the Right Side Border (**Fig. 14**).
18. Sew together (11) assorted small block squares and (10) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " **Fabric F** strips as shown to make the $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $54\frac{1}{2}$ " Top Border (**Fig. 15**). Repeat to make the Bottom Border (**Fig. 16**).

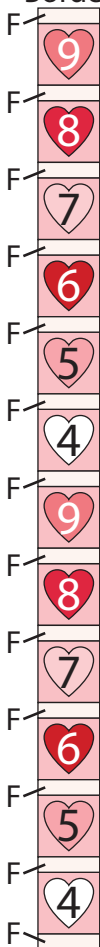
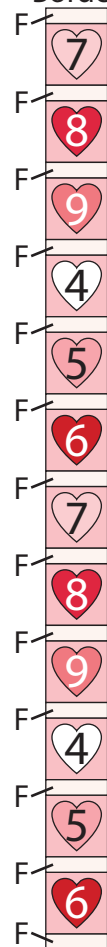

Quilt Top Assembly

Follow the Quilt Layout (Page 8) while assembling the quilt top.

19. Sew (1) 2½" x 53½" **Fabric E** strip to each side of the Quilt Center. Sew (1) 2½" **Fabric I** square to each end of (1) 2½" x 40½" **Fabric E** strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew (1) newly sewn strip to the top and bottom of the Quilt Center.
20. Sew (1) 1½" x 57½" **Fabric F** strip to each side of the Quilt Center. Sew (1) 2½" x 46½" **Fabric F** strip to the top and bottom of the Quilt Center.
21. Sew the Left Side Border and Right Side Border to the left and right side of the Quilt Center. Sew the Top Border and Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Quilt Center.
22. Sew (1) 1½" x 69½" **Fabric F** strip to each side of the Quilt Center. Sew (1) 1½" x 56½" **Fabric F** strip to the top and bottom of the Quilt Center to complete the quilt top which should measure 56½" x 71½".

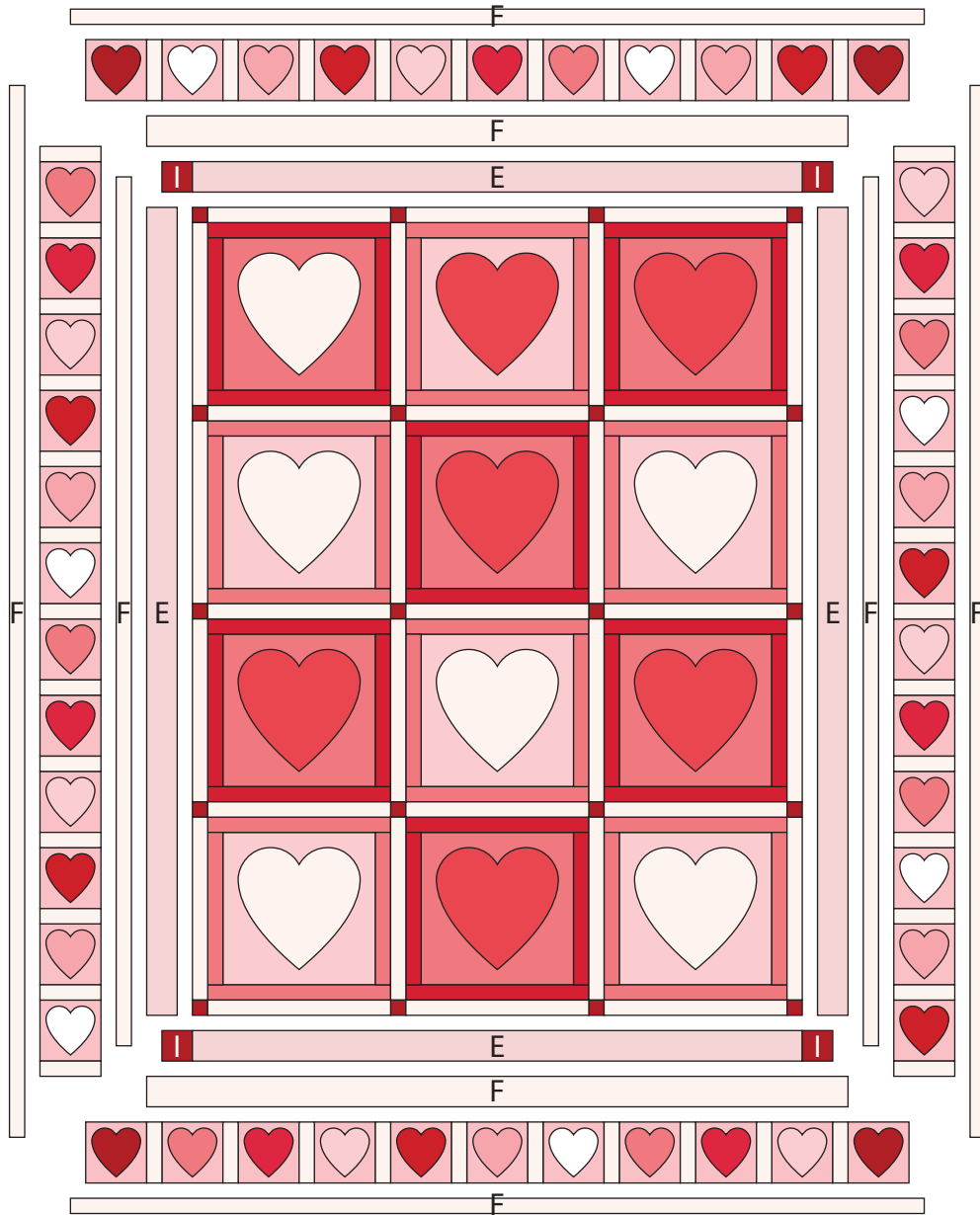
Layering, Quilting and Finishing

23. Layer the backing (wrong side up), batting, and quilt top (right side up). Baste the layers together and quilt as desired. Trim excess batting and backing even with the top of the quilt.

Binding

24. Sew together (7) 2½" x WOF **Fabric I** binding strips end to end with diagonal seams. Press the seams open. Press the binding strip in half wrong sides together.
25. Leaving an 8" tail of binding and beginning along an edge of the quilt top, match raw edges of the binding to the raw edges of the quilt top. Sew the binding to the outside edge around all four sides and miter corners. Stop sewing approximately 12" from where you started and backstitch.
26. Lay both loose ends of binding flat along the quilt edge. Where these two loose ends meet, fold them back onto themselves and press to form a crease. Using this crease as your stitching line, sew the two open ends of the binding together, right sides matching. Trim seam to ¼" and press seam open. Finish sewing the binding to the quilt top.
27. Turn the binding over the raw edge to the back of the quilt and hand or machine stitch in place.

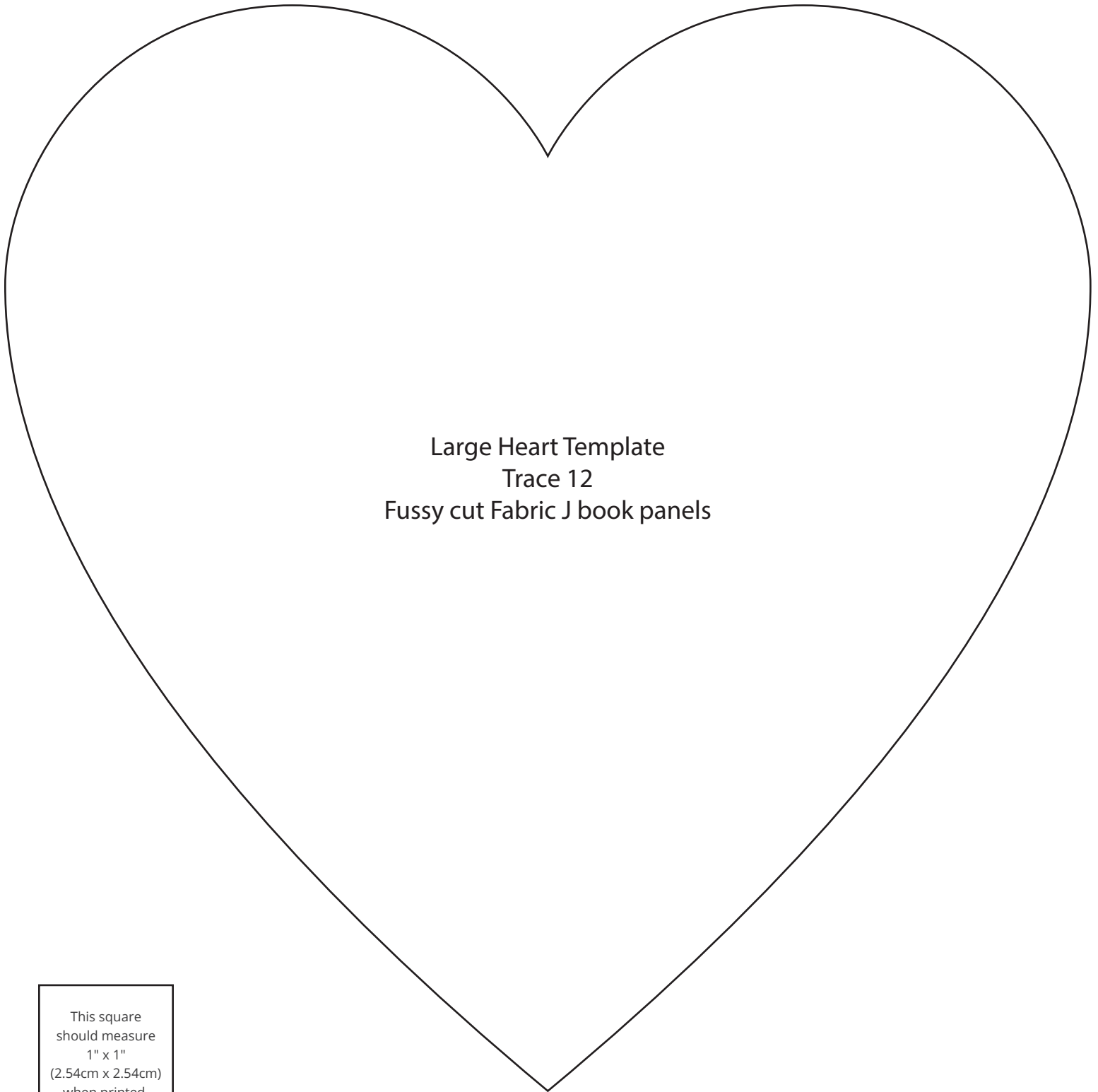
Quilt Layout

Fussy cut Fabric J book panels

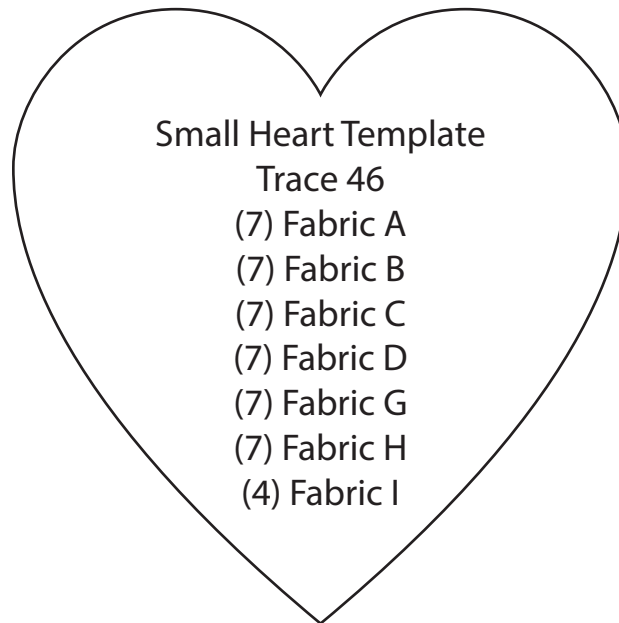
