

(D) Mini Wild Flowers	Soft Pink	9012-22	7/8 yard (0.80m)
(E) Ditsie	Serene Blue	9013-17	1 1/3 yards (1.22m)
(F) Polka Dot	Rose	9015-29	7/8 yard (0.80m)
(G) Peppered Cottons	White	White Sugar-9	1 2/3 yards (1.52m)



Cutting Instructions

Notes:

- Please make sure to check *studiofabrics.net* for pattern updates prior to starting the project.
- All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

Fabrics A, C, D, and F, from each cut:

(2) 13½" x WOF; subcut (5) 13½" squares

Fabric B, cut:

(6) 2½" x WOF for binding

Fabric E, cut:

(13) 3" x WOF; subcut (160) 3" squares

Fabric G, cut:

(1) 12½" x WOF; subcut:

(20) 1½" x 12½" rectangles

(6) 1½" x 6" rectangles

(2) 6" x WOF; subcut (34) 1½" x 6" rectangles,
total of (40)

(6) 2½" x WOF for the border

(8) 2" x WOF; subcut (160) 2" squares

SEWING

Note: All seam allowances are $\frac{1}{4}$ " (0.64cm). Sew pieces with right sides together. Press seam allowances open unless otherwise indicated.

1. Draw two diagonal lines on the wrong side of the $13\frac{1}{2}$ " **Fabric D** squares (a). Layer a marked **Fabric D** square atop a $13\frac{1}{2}$ " **Fabric A** square. Stitch $\frac{1}{4}$ " from each side of the diagonal lines (b), cut vertically and horizontally to make four equal squares (c), then cut each square on the drawn lines to make eight half-square triangles (d). Flip open, press, and trim to 6" squares. Repeat with the remaining **Fabrics D** and **A** squares to make (40) 6" half-square triangles. Repeat this step with the $13\frac{1}{2}$ " squares of **Fabrics C** and **F** to make (40) 6" half-square triangles (**Fig. 1**).



2. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the 3" **Fabric E** squares. With right sides together, place a marked **Fabric E** square on a corner of a step 1 unit and stitch on the drawn line. Repeat with the opposite corner of the same unit, as shown. Trim the seam allowances to $\frac{1}{4}$ ", flip open, and press. Repeat with the remaining step 1 units and the **Fabric E** squares. Similarly, mark and sew the 2" **Fabric G** squares to the **Fabric E** corners of all units (**Fig. 2**).



3. Sew a $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 6" **Fabric G** rectangle between one unit of each type to make (40) rows as shown. Press the seams toward the center. Sew a $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $12\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle between two rows, noting the orientation of the bottom row. Press the seams toward the center. Repeat to make (20) $12\frac{1}{2}$ " blocks (**Fig. 3**).

QUILT TOP ASSEMBLY

Note: Follow the Quilt Layout Diagram (page 6) while assembling the quilt top.

4. Lay out the blocks in (5) rows of (4) blocks. Sew the blocks together and press the seams in opposite directions from row to row.
5. For the border, sew the (6) 2½" **Fabric G** strips together end to end. Measure the vertical length of the quilt top through the center and cut (2) border strips to that length. Sew one strip to each side of the quilt top and press the seams toward the borders. Measure the width of the quilt top through the center. Cut (2) border strips to that length and sew one to the top and the other to the bottom. Press the seams toward the borders.
7. Layer the backing (wrong side up), batting, and quilt top (right side up). Baste the layers together and quilt as desired. Trim excess batting and backing even with the top of the quilt.
8. Leaving an 8" tail of binding and beginning along an edge of the quilt top, matching the raw edges of the binding to the raw edges of the quilt. Sew the binding to the outside edge around all four sides and miter corners. Stop sewing approximately 12" from where you started and backstitch.
9. Lay both loose ends of the binding flat along the quilt edge. Where these two loose ends meet, fold them back onto themselves and press to form a crease. Using this crease as your stitching line, sew the two open ends of the binding together, with the right sides matching. Trim the seam to ¼" and press it open. Finish sewing the binding to the quilt.
6. Sew together the (6) 2½" **Fabric B** binding strips end to end using diagonal seams. Press the seams open. Press the binding strip in half with the wrong sides together.
10. Turn the binding over the raw edge to the back of the quilt and hand or machine stitch in place.


