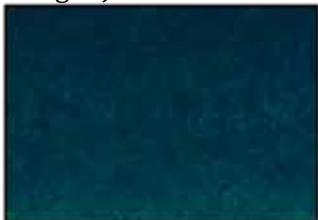

Cutting

Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

WOF= Width of Fabric • LOF = Length of Fabric

Fabric A (4492-77 Birds and Wildflowers – Midnight), cut:

- (1) 9 ½" square.

Fabric B (4493-58 Wildflower Toss – Eggplant), cut:

- (1) 3 ⅛" x WOF strip, sub-cut (8) 3 ⅛" squares.
- (1) 7 ⅜" x WOF strip, sub-cut (4) 7 ⅜" squares.
- (3) 1 ¾" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ¾" x 56" strips.
- (3) 1 ¾" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ¾" x 53 ½" strips.

Fabric C (4492-76 Birds and Wildflowers – Light Spruce), cut:

- (3) 19" x WOF strips, sub-cut (12) 9 ¾" x 19" strips.
- (1) 3 ⅛" x WOF strip, sub-cut (8) 3 ⅛" squares.

Fabric D (4493-70 Wildflower Toss – Blue), cut:

- (6) 9 ¾" x WOF strips, sub-cut (24) 9 ¾" squares.
- (1) 5 ⅜" x WOF strip, sub-cut (2) 5 ⅜" squares.
- (1) 2 ¾" x WOF strips, sub-cut (4) 2 ¾" x 9 ½" strips.

Fabric E (True Royal-77 Peppered Cottons – True Royal), cut:

- (1) 5 ⅜" x WOF strip, sub-cut (2) 5 ⅜" squares.

Fabric F (4493-77 Wildflower Toss – Midnight), cut:

- (3) 5 ⅜" x WOF strip, sub-cut (16) 5 ⅜" squares.

Fabric G (4497-76 Fern – Light Spruce), cut:

- (2) 5 ⅜" x WOF strip, sub-cut (8) 5 ⅜" squares.

Fabric H (4492-58 Birds and Wildflowers – Eggplant), cut:

- (1) 5 ⅛" x WOF strip, sub-cut (8) 5 ⅛" squares.
- See instructions to cut (8) Template 1 triangles.

Fabric I (4498-76 Medallion – Light Spruce), cut:

- See instructions to cut (4) Template 2 triangles.

Fabric J (4493-55 Wildflower Toss – Purple), cut:

- (1) 7 ⅜" x WOF strip, sub-cut (4) 7 ⅜" squares.
- (1) 5 ⅛" x WOF strip, sub-cut (8) 5 ⅛" squares.

Fabric K (Surf-75 Peppered Cottons – Surf), cut:

- (2) 7" x WOF strips, sub-cut (8) 7" squares.

Fabric L (4495-76 Ombre Texture – Jade), cut:

- (8) 5 ⅜" x WOF strips. Fussy cut (1) 5 ⅜" square from the bright section of each strip for (8) 5 ⅜" squares total.

Fabric M (4499-77 Agate Texture – Midnight), cut:

- (1) 5" x WOF strip, sub-cut (4) 5" squares.

Fabric N (4493-66 Wildflower Toss – Green), cut:

- (4) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 ½" x 78 ½" strips.
- (4) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 ½" x 74 ½" strips.

Cutting - Continued

Fabric O (4497-77 Fern – Midnight), cut:

- (5) 5 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 5 ½" x 88 ½" strips.
- (4) 5 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 5 ½" x 78 ½" strips.
- (9) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

Fabric P (4495-77 Ombre Texture – Midnight), cut:

- (8) 5" x 13 ½" LOF strips.

Backing (4493-76 Wildflowers Toss – Light Jade), cut:

- (3) 96" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together and trim to 96" x 96" to make the back.

Sewing

Sew using a ¼" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise indicated. Always press towards the darker fabric while assembling, unless otherwise noted by the arrows.

Block Assembly

1. Place (1) 3 ⅞" Fabric C square on top of (1) 3 ⅞" Fabric B square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Fig. 1). Sew ¼" away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 1). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 2) to make (2) half-square triangles. Trim the blocks to measure 2 ¾" to make (2) Unit 1 blocks (Fig. 3). Repeat to make (16) Unit 1 blocks total.

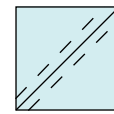

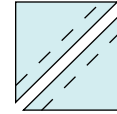

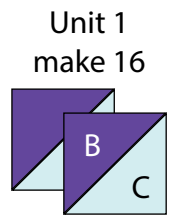

2. Repeat Step 1 using (2) 5 ⅜" Fabric D squares and (2) 5 ⅜" Fabric E squares to make (4) 5" Unit 2 blocks (Fig. 4).
3. Repeat Step 1 using (8) 5 ⅜" Fabric G squares and (8) 5 ⅜" Fabric F squares to make (16) 5" Unit 3 blocks (Fig. 5).
4. Repeat Step 1 using (8) 5 ⅜" Fabric F squares and (8) 5 ⅜" Fabric L squares to make (16) 5" Unit 4 blocks (Fig. 6).
5. Repeat Step 1 using (4) 7 ⅜" Fabric J squares and (4) 7 ⅜" Fabric B squares to make (8) 7" Unit 5 blocks (Fig. 7).

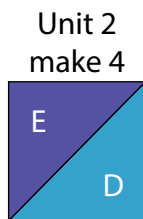

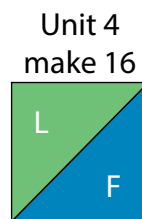

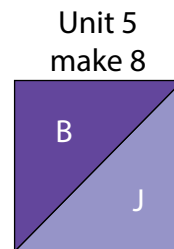

6. Follow Figure 8 and sew (1) Fabric H-Template 1 triangle to each short side of (1) Fabric I-Template 2 triangle to make (1) Unit 6 strip. Repeat to make (4) Unit 6 strips total.

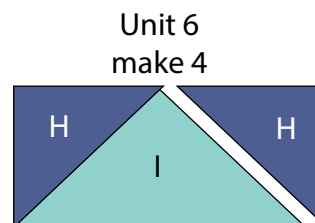

7. Sew (4) Unit 1 blocks together, paying attention to the orientation of the units. Sew (1) 2 ¾" x 9 ½" Fabric D strip to the bottom of the sewn strip lengthwise to make (1) Unit 7 strip (Fig. 9). Repeat to make (4) Unit 7 strips total.

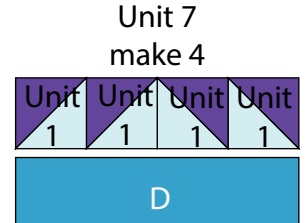

8. Sew (1) Unit 7 strip to each side of (1) 9 1/2" Fabric A square. Sew (1) Unit 2 to each end of (1) Unit 7 strip, paying attention to the orientation of the units. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A square to make (1) Unit 8 block (Fig. 10).

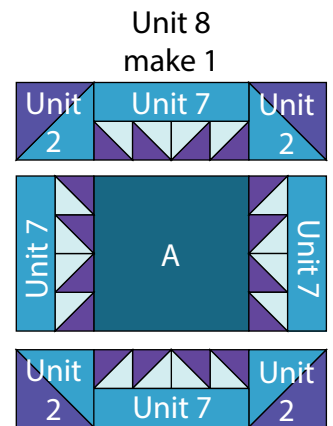

9. Sew (4) Unit 3 blocks together, paying attention to the orientation of units. Sew (1) Unit 6 strip to the top of the sewn strip to make (1) Unit 9 block (Fig. 11). Repeat to make (4) Unit 9 blocks total.

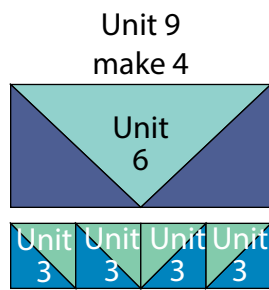

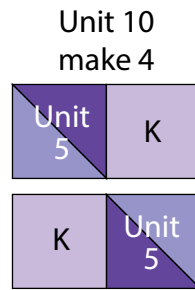

10. Sew (1) Unit 5 block to the left side of (1) 7" Fabric K square. Sew (1) 7" Fabric K square to the left side of (1) Unit 5 block. Sew the (2) strips together lengthwise to make (1) Unit 10 block (Fig. 12). Repeat to make (4) Unit 10 blocks total.

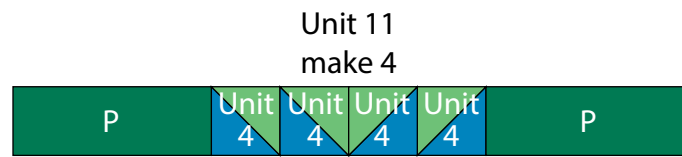

12. Sew (1) Unit 9 strip to each side of the Unit 8 block. Sew (1) Unit 10 block to each end of (1) Unit 9 strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 8 block (Fig. 14).

13. Sew (1) Unit 11 strip to each side of the block from Step 12. Sew (1) 5" Fabric M square to each end of (1) Unit 11 strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the block from Step 12 to make the Center Block (Fig. 14).

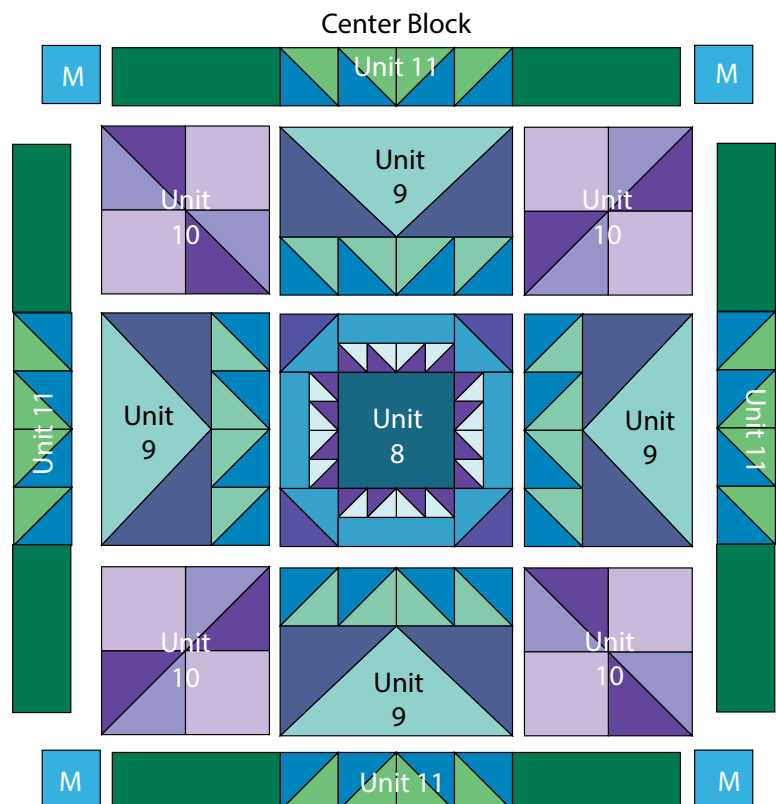

14. Sew (1) 5 1/8" Fabric J square to the left side of (1) 5 1/8" Fabric H square. Sew (1) 5 1/8" Fabric H square to the left side of (1) 5 1/8" Fabric J square. Sew the (2) strips together lengthwise to make (1) Unit 12 block (Fig. 15). Repeat to make (4) Unit 12 blocks total.

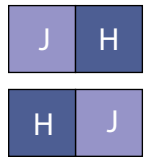

15. Place (1) 9 3/4" Fabric D square on the left side of (1) 9 3/4" x 19" Fabric C strip, right sides together (Fig. 16). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 16). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 17). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance.

16. Place another 9 3/4" Fabric D square on the right side of the 9 3/4" x 19" Fabric C strip, right sides together (Fig. 18). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 18). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance to make (1) Unit 13 strip (Fig. 19).

17. Repeat Steps 15-16 to make (12) Unit 13 strips total.

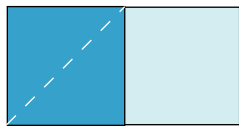

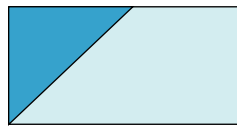

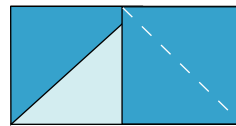

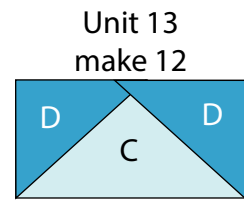

18. Sew (3) Unit 13 strips together end to end, paying attention to the orientation of the strips to make (1) Unit 14 strip (Fig. 20). Repeat to make (4) Unit 14 strips total.

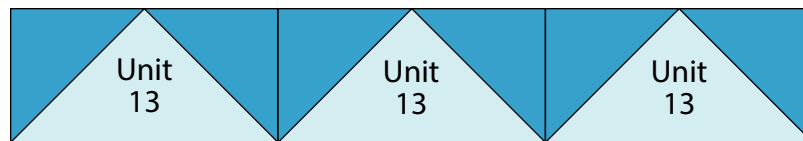

19. Sew (1) Unit 12 block to each end of (1) Unit 13 strip to make (1) Unit 15 strip. Repeat to make a second Unit 15 strip (Fig. 21).

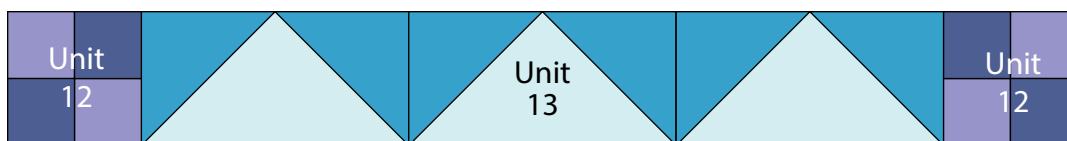

Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout on Page 9 while assembling the quilt top.)

20. Sew $1\frac{3}{4}$ " x $53\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $1\frac{3}{4}$ " x 56" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

21. Sew (1) Unit 14 strip to each side of the Center Block.

22. Sew (1) Unit 15 strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

23. Sew (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $74\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric N strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $78\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric N strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

24. Sew (1) $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $78\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric O strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $88\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric O strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

Layering, Quilting and Finishing

25. Press the quilt top and 96" x 96" backing well. Layer backing (wrong side up), batting, pressed quilt top (right side up) and baste. Quilt as desired and trim excess batting and backing when quilting is complete.

Binding

26. Cut the ends of the (9) Fabric O binding strips at a 45-degree angle and sew end to end to make (1) continuous piece of binding. Fold in half lengthwise and press wrong sides together.

27. Sew the binding to the front of the quilt, raw edges together. Turn the folded edge to the back, and hand stitch in place.

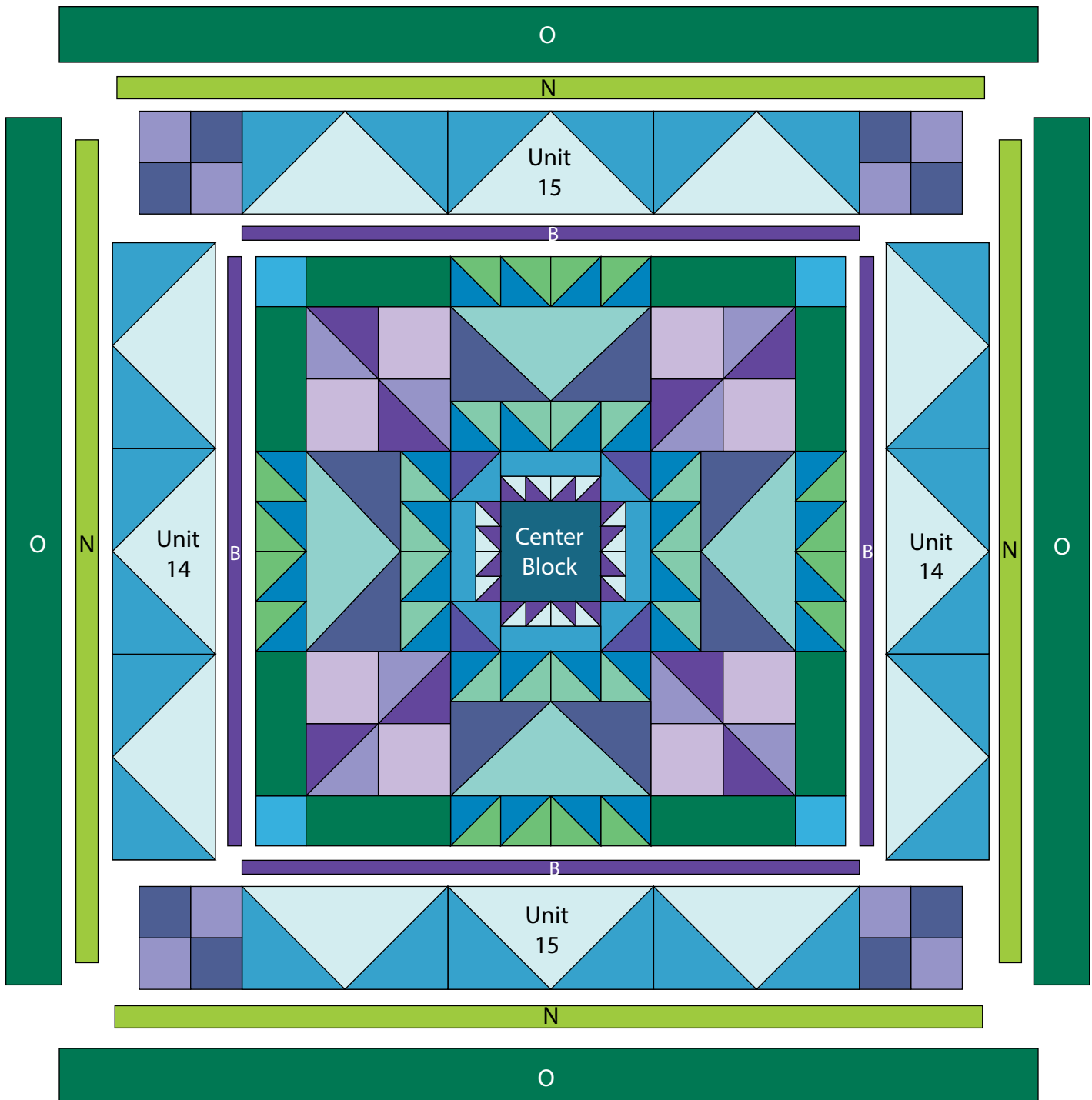
