(C) 6238-11	1/4 yard
(D) 1351-Lipstick**	3/4 yard

Additional Supplies Needed

(2) 14" x 17 1/2" strips of Fusible Fleece
(2) 1" x 42" strips of Fusible Fleece
Piecing and sewing thread
Quilting and sewing supplies

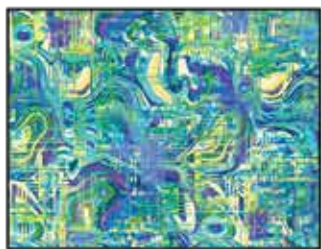

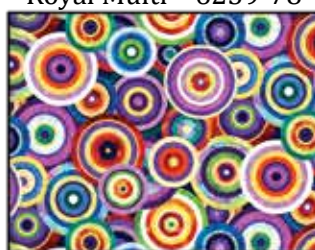

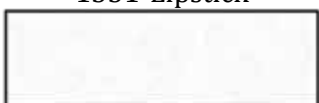

Cutting

Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

WOF= Width of Fabric • LOF = Length of Fabric

Fabric A (6244-11 Geofetti Hexis – Bright Multi), cut:

- (1) 17 ½" x WOF strip, sub-cut (2) 10 ½" x 17 ½" strips.

Fabric B (6235-83 Geofetti Texture – Flame), cut:

- (1) 3" x WOF strip, sub-cut (2) 3" x 3 ¾" strips and (6) 3" x 2 ¼" strips

Fabric C (6238-11 Geo Garden – White Multi), cut:

- (1) 3" x WOF strip, sub-cut (2) 3" x 3 ¾" strips and (6) 3" x 2 ¼" strips

Fabric D (1351-Lipstick Just Color! – Lipstick), cut:

- (2) 4" x WOF strips.
- (1) 1 ½" x WOF strip, sub-cut (2) 1 ½" x 17 ½" strips
- (1) 14" x WOF strip, sub-cut (2) 14" x 17 ½" strips

Sewing

Sew using a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise indicated. Always press towards the darker fabric while assembling, unless otherwise noted by the arrows.

Bag Assembly

1. Refer to Figure 1 to sew together (1) $3" \times 3\frac{3}{4}"$ Fabric B strip, (3) $3" \times 2\frac{1}{4}"$ Fabric B strips, (3) $3" \times 2\frac{1}{4}"$ Fabric C strips and (1) $3" \times 3\frac{3}{4}"$ Fabric C strip to make the bottom strip. Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{2}" \times 17\frac{1}{2}"$ Fabric D strip to the top of the newly sewn strip. Sew (1) $10\frac{1}{2}" \times 17\frac{1}{2}"$ Fabric A strip to the top of the Fabric D strip to make (1) Unit 1 rectangle. Repeat to make a second Unit 1 rectangle.

2. Press (1) $14" \times 17\frac{1}{2}"$ fusible fleece onto the back side of each Unit 1 rectangle and quilt as desired to make the Bag Front and Bag Back.

3. Place the Bag Front and Bag Back right sides together. Stitch down the two short sides and across the bottom to make the Outer Bag (Fig. 2).

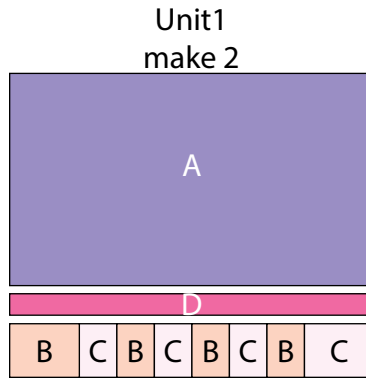

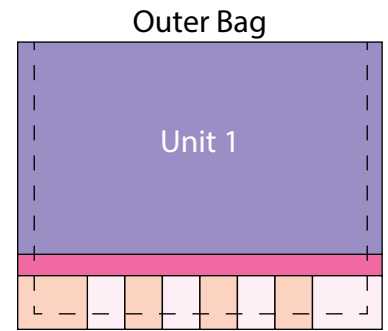

4. Measure in from the side edge $1\frac{1}{2}"$ and up from the bottom edge $1\frac{1}{2}"$ at each bottom corner of the Outer Bag. Cut out the square of fabric (Fig. 3).

5. Open the cut bottom and align the bottom edge with the side edge and sew the two edges together (Fig. 4). Repeat with the other bottom corner to make the box bottom on the Outer Bag.

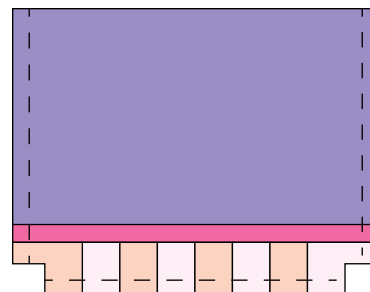

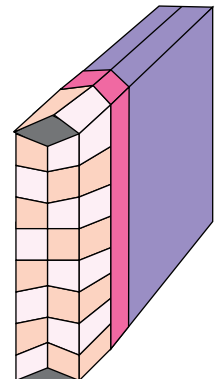

6. Place the (2) $14" \times 17\frac{1}{2}"$ Fabric D strips right sides together. Stitch down the two short sides and across the bottom, leaving a 4" opening for turning to create the Lining (Fig. 5).

7. Repeat Steps 4-5 to create a box corner on each bottom corner of the Lining (Fig. 6).

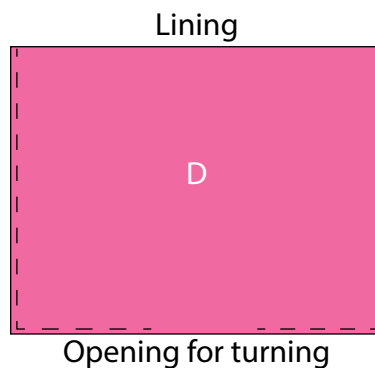

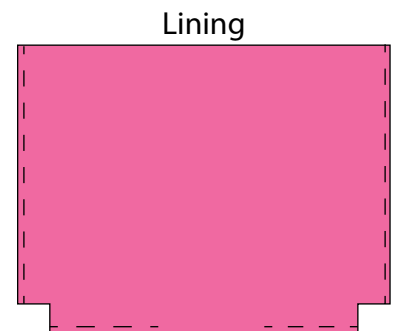
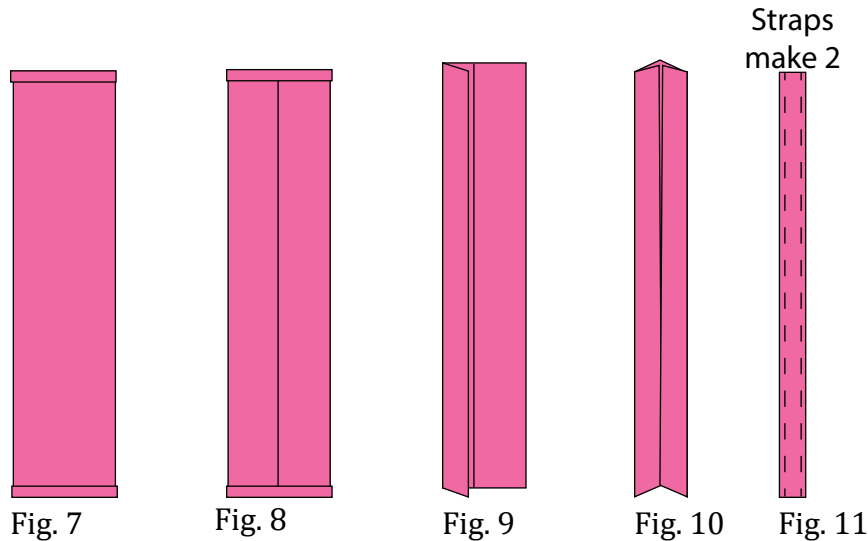

8. Measure and trim each 4" x WOF Fabric D strip to the desired strap length. Fold down each short side of the trimmed strips, ¼" wrong sides together and press (Fig. 7).

9. Fold (1) 4" x WOF strip in half lengthwise and press (Fig. 8). Open the folded fabric and fold each long edge to the creased centerline and press (Fig. 9).

10. Fold the pressed fabric in half again and press to make (1) 1" x WOF strip (Fig. 10). Slide (1) 1" strip of fusible fleece into the tube and press. Top stitch down both long sides 1/8" in from the edge to make (1) Strap (Fig. 11). Repeat to make a second Strap.



11. Place the Outer Bag, right sides together with the Lining, aligning the top raw edges of the Outer Bag and Lining, pin together. Sew the Lining and Outer Bag together (Fig. 12). Turn the Outer Bag and Lining unit right side out through the opening in the Lining. Press as needed and top stitch the opening closed. Put the Lining into the bag, aligning the sides and bottom.

12. Position (1) Strap on the Bag Front about 4" in from the sides and pin in place. Top stitch the strap in place (Fig.12). Repeat with the second strap and the Bag Back to complete the Bag.

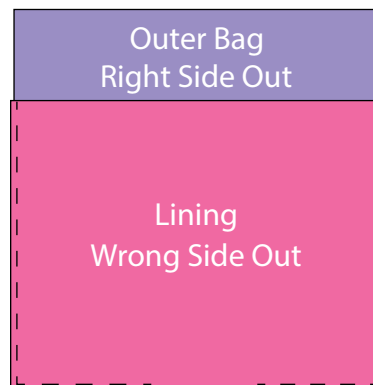

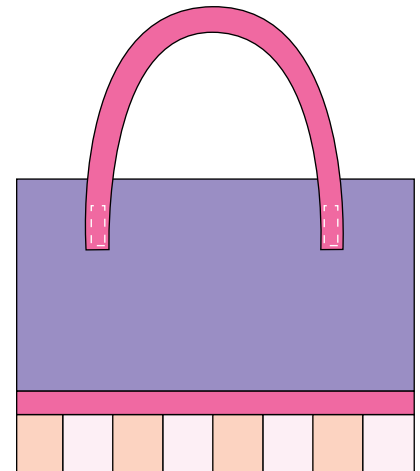
